Development of WEB application for access to electronic medical records

Multi-profile hospital for Active Treatment "Dr. Atanas Dafovski" AD outsourced and finally installed a new application that enables remote access to patient electronic medical records. The application has been developed for both Android OS and iOS, and can also be accessed via WEB using a Desktop Computer and a common browser.

More specifically, the application:

- Enables GPs in remote areas to access a patient's record stored in the hospital
 Information System (HIS) administrative, demographic, and clinical
 information facts are available, such as family history, problems (diagnoses),
 allergies, medications, vital signs/physiological measurements, lab
 results/observations, procedures/imaging, discharge documents etc.
- Enables GPs to schedule visits and admissions and attach referral data.
- And also gives access to patients to their own laboratory results.
