The bigger picture: three steps of LaunchPad

- Connect research infrastructures and support the 'launch' of cooperation projects in the field of Photon and Neutron Science
- ► Test and evaluate support instrument

Approach of three steps:

- Symposium match-making >> draft proposals for collaboration projects
- 2. Forum Expert Panel >> draft proposals selected for Coaching
- 3. Coaching support for further developing the draft proposals











Symposium - just a beginning of the journey...

- Conference + hackathon
- >> your feedback on the process
- >> project idea drafts
- We will not stop here >> support for further development of the project draft





Why continue the journey with LaunchPad?

- Feedback from the Expert Panel
- Financial support by LaunchPad Coaching for selected projects

Budget for LaunchPad Coaching:

15 000 EUR, no limits per project









LaunchPad Coaching

- NO guarantee for funding to the drafted project or getting "measurement time" at the research facility
- NO research grants or co-funding to research grants
- Support for the development of "soft skills", team-building, partnership
- Support tailor-made and negotiated for every selected project



LaunchPad Coaching



- Project partners meetings/events
- Partner search/widening partnership
- ► Identification of suitable funding opportunities, meeting potential funders and stakeholders
- ► Study trips, training, expert exchange visits
- Consultations
- Other activities needed for further development of the drafted project









Not fitting under LaunchPad Coaching

- Costs not connected to the drafted project activities or not contributing to the Baltic Sea Region
- Staff and administration costs
- Buying chemicals and equipment
- Publications
- Costs for "passive" participation (e.g. listener at the conference)
- Costs not covered due to financial rules of Interreg
- Possibly other costs negotiated and fixed case-by-case

How to continue the journey with LaunchPad?



Short project idea drafts for collaboration:

- I. Motivation for the proposal
- II. The scientific/engineering background of the proposal
- III. Method(s), experimental and technical requirements
- IV. Expected results and their impact
- V. Collaboration
- VI. Preliminary action plan for further development of the project
- >> Submission by the end of the hackathon or by November 16 (online)
- >> Not for the hackathon participants only!











Project ideas with a potential

Open to all kinds of proposals!

The Expert Panel will follow the general evaluation criteria:

- 1. Scientific/engineering excellence and relevance
- 2. Collaboration aspects
- 3. Wider importance and (potential) impact of the project
- 4. Potential for further development of the project idea and continuation of collaboration











What will happen next?

- 1. Expert Panel meeting (December 2020)
 - Reviewing the draft proposals and meeting with the project teams
 - Feedback to every draft proposal
 - Selection for Coaching
- 2. Negotiating and confirming Coaching activities
- 3. Coaching activities January May 2021
