Introduction

Feedbacks an Action Plan 2/2

- Actions envisaged in our proposal seem to be too many
- Actions have to be concrete. They should start during the project lifetime
- The link between the action and the project (i.e. the good practice or aspect discussed during the project that inspired the action) has to be clear

Mid-term Review

Feedbacks on Action Plan 2/2

- **The way the action contributes to improving the policy instrument has to be explained. It is possible to make reference to the type of policy improvements described in the programme manual:**
 - new project
 - improved governance
 - structural change
- **It is recommended to focus on a small number of actions well defined. There are usually between 2 and 5 actions in an AP.**
- **Endorsement of the APs may require time and has to be anticipated by the partners. Specific meetings with the MAs during the preparation of the AP can help. If an AP addresses several policy instruments, it can be divided in several sections endorsed by the responsible bodies.**

Feedbacks on Policy Instrument

One action plan, one policy instrument: it's better

Decide to steer another PI:

justify it in the introduction of the action plan

Not put some actions in the Action plan, if the actions are not for the PI addressed

Foresee, keep them, but then monitor them in Phase 2

ASK US concerning new PI – we will share it with the JS

Mid-term Review

Feedbacks on Self defined indicators

Keep the indicators and built a new indicator once you get a policy change, in order to make it measurable

It is possible to add a new one that fits better the need of the partner when reporting a territorial impact following a policy change

An indicator must monitor after the Policy change occurs

PP06: need to obtain the endorsement

PP6 to finalise the AP and get the endorsement from the MA.

It seems that the MA did not take part in the stakeholder meetings and that the work on CIRCE is not discussed sufficiently with the MA. Additional meetings may have to be organised between PP6 and the MA to prepare the AP and ensure the commitment of the Region in the implementation of the AP.

If this testing requires funding and the ‘importing’ region does not have this funding for different reasons, the project may apply to the Interreg Europe programme before the end of phase 1 to carry out a pilot action.

Main Conclusions on Action plan and related issues

As soon as possible:

- Submit to the JS the draft of the action plans
- It is recommended that a short description of the pilot action ideas is checked with the JS (**by phone or email**) to check the relevance before preparing the full request.
- Remind PP6 its obligations regarding the work to be done with the MA and the preparation

Before the end of phase 1:

- Send pilot action request template fully filled in with budget.

At the end of phase 1:

- Submit finalised APs. All APs have to be approved by the JS in order that the PR5 can be approved.
