

Timeline of Delivery and Expansion





- Successful from start
- Expansion
- 1080 spaces, operates at 80-100% capacity
- Tram and bus, 7.5minute frequency
- 35 minutes to city centre by tram
- Development proposed potential threat







- Successful from start
- 450 spaces
- Frequently at capacity
- Expansion required
- 25 minutes to city centre by bus
- 10 minute frequency

Hermiston






- Slow start, got worse.
- 650 spaces
- 25% capacity
- 30 minutes to city centre by bus










Lothian Buses Network








Other findings:

- 75% of site users chose the tram for their onward journey.
- The vast majority said they would use the site again, suggesting they may be regular users.
- More spaces, facilities and road signs were cited as areas for improvement.
