

4 Policy changes:

Finland's structural funds program 2014-2020

The Council of Tampere Region (FI) + The Baltic Institute of Finland (FI) Sector specific funding calls have been launched for the application and exploitation of Artificial Intelligence.



Basque Government (ES)

Launch of an interregional voucher scheme (300.000 EUR)

Lombardy ERDF ROP 2014-2020

AFIL - Intelligent Factory Lombardy Cluster (IT)

Improvements of the Innodriver S3-2017 voucher programme (fixed cost for the services, a standard cost for staff)

NORTE 2020 OP

National Innovation Agency (PT)


New call "Demonstration Projects - Seal of Excellence", phase 2 of the SME Instrument (13.250.000 EUR)



Some lessons learnt



- Interreg Europe: direct contribution to co-investments
 Learn & connect / 9 projects related to TSSP
- Interreg Europe also serves more advanced regions



Co-investment: very challenging (few genuine examples so far)

What about the future?

- May 2018: Interreg Europe not present in the EC draft proposal for 2021-2027: pan European interregional cooperation no longer possible!
- Since then: negotiation with EP and Council who asked for Interreg Europe to be back
- To be continued.... (finalisation of regulation, budget decision)
