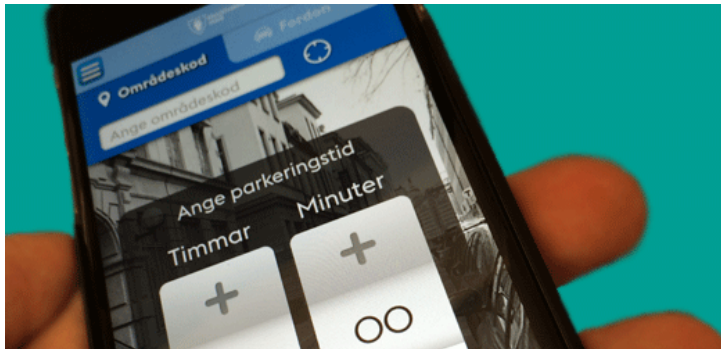

Good practices

- **Urban ICT Arena testbed & World's first 5G Bike:** sensors measure humidity, UV radiation,...
- **KTH Pilot on Real-time crowding information:** information on load of metro trains.
- **Trafiklab: community for open traffic data, fostering transportation entrepreneurship**

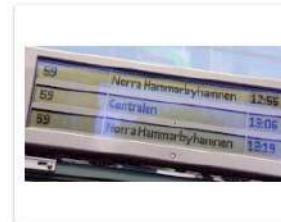

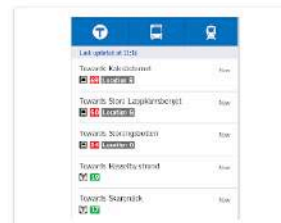

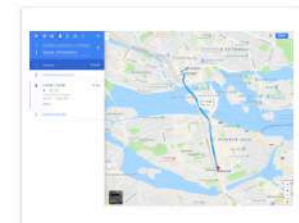
