Based on local needs: Importance of stakeholders

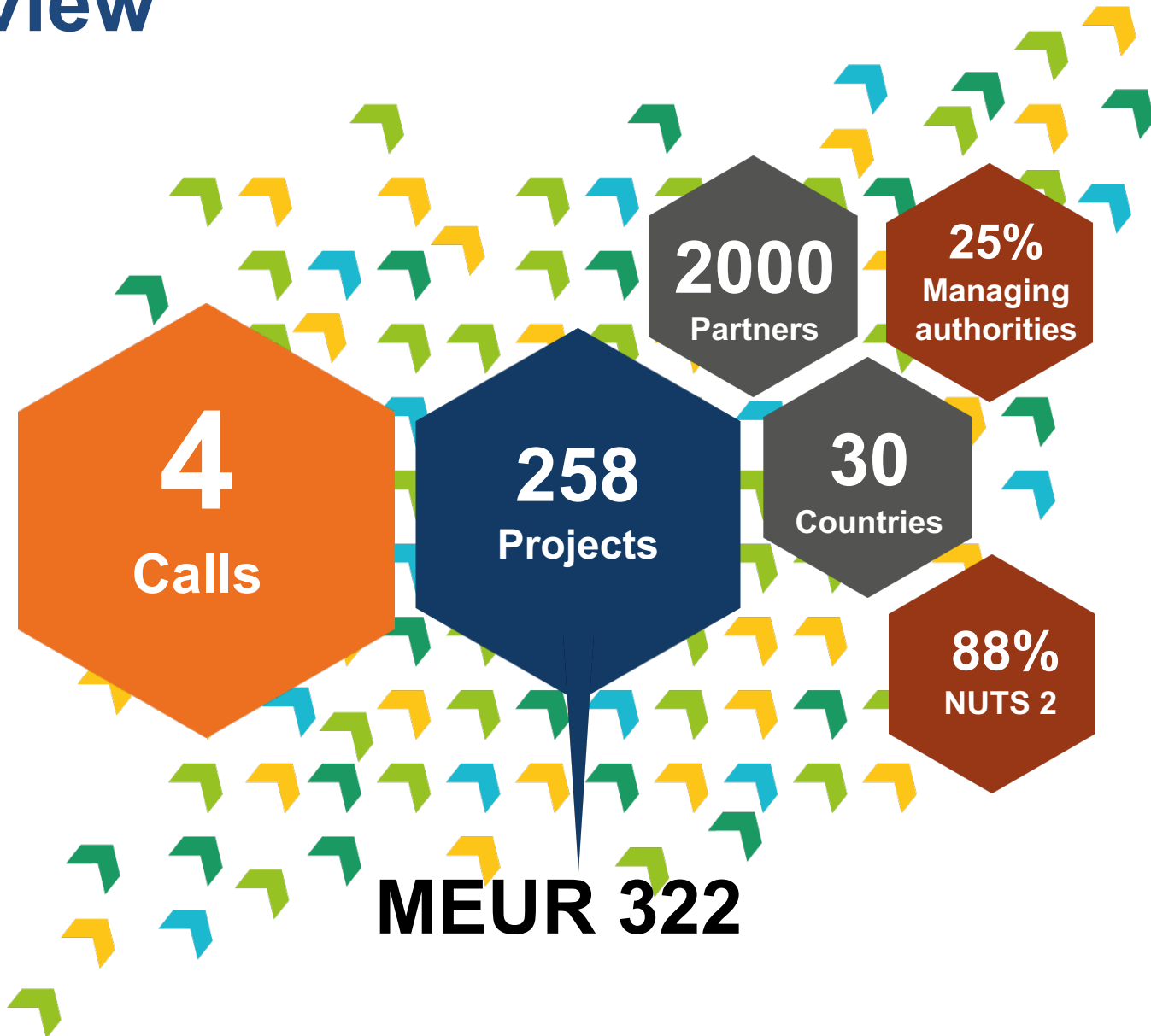
Focus on results: 2 phases of projects (exchange of experience + implementation)

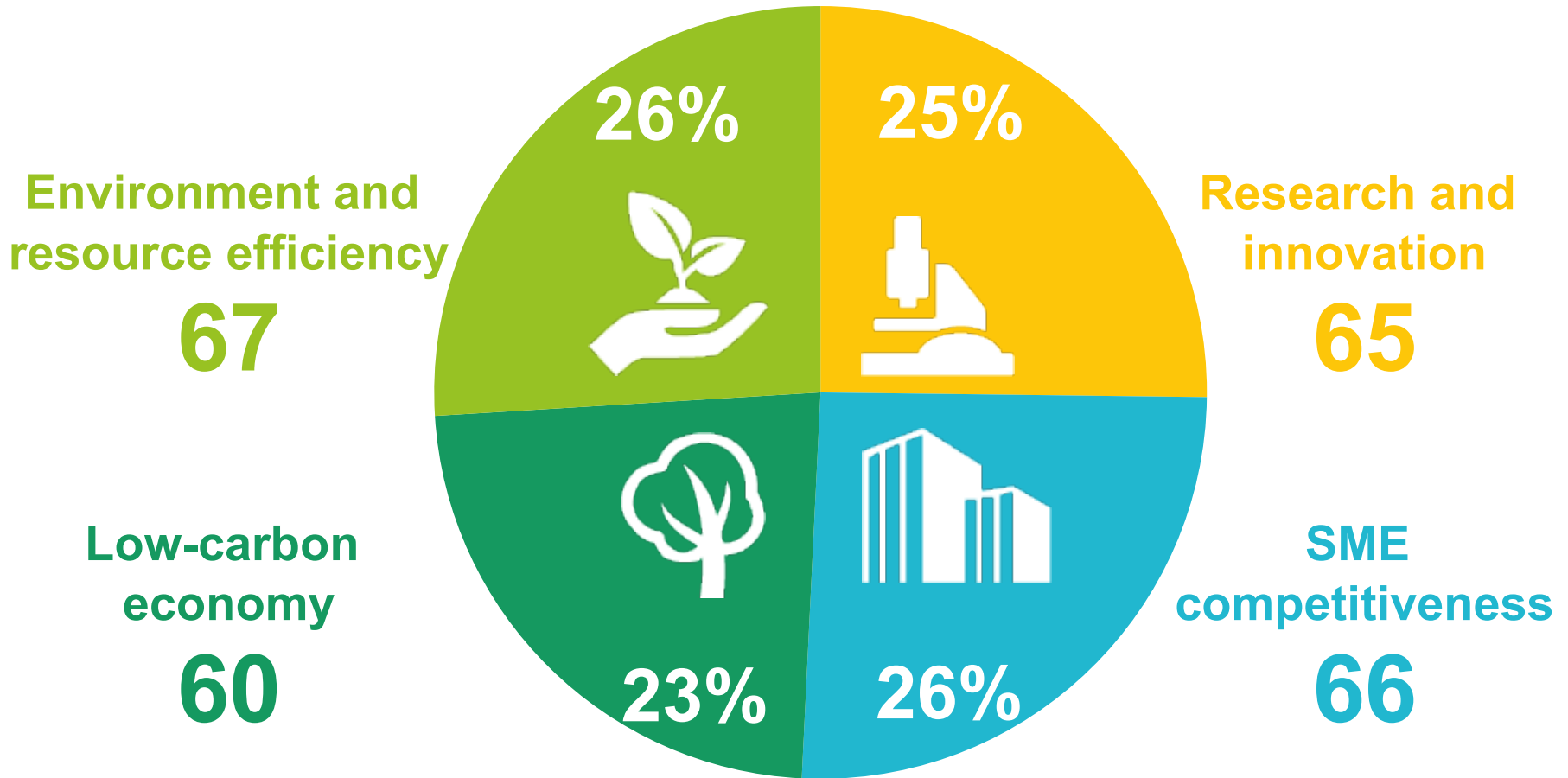

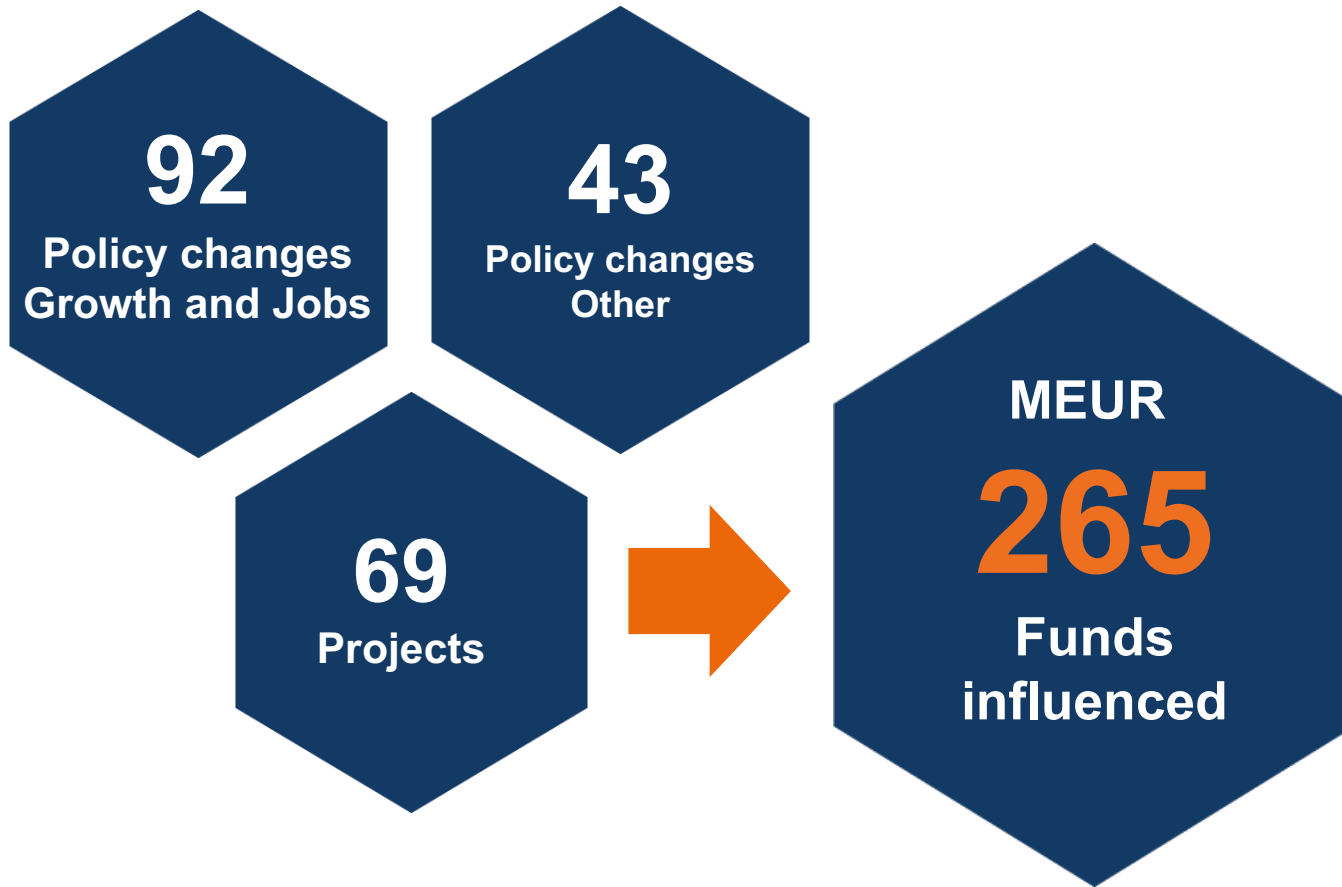

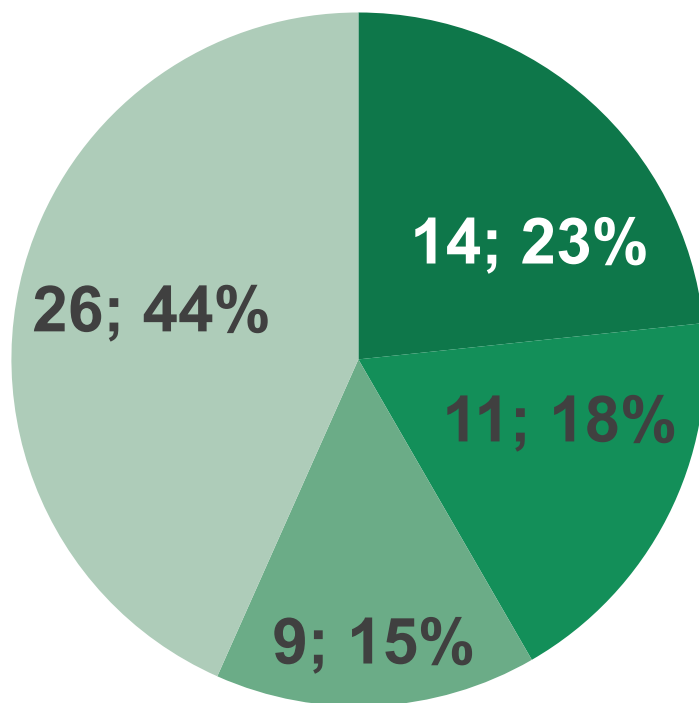

Sustainable Mobility Strategy for the Municipality of Agueda

Águeda Sm@rt City Lab project plans to

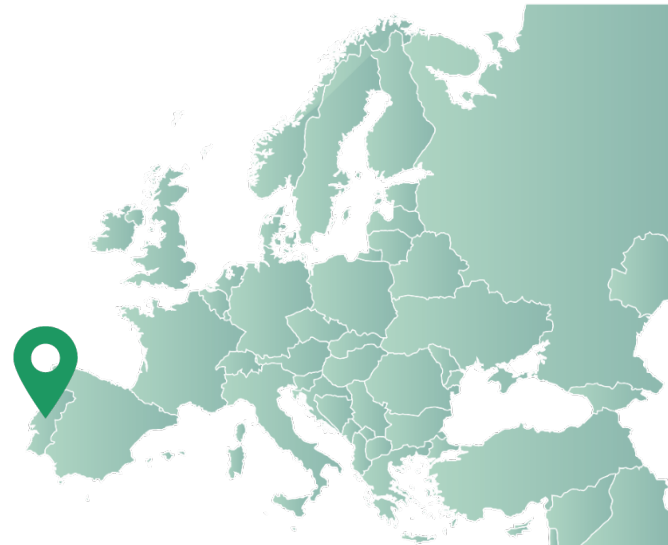
- monitor GHG thanks to sensors in electric bicycles (5) to promote this travel mode in the city of Agueda
- Install ICT systems in city transport hub
- ...

→ Approx. EUR 45,000 directly influenced (municipal level)

→ Co-financed by Portuguese Environmental Fund (Ministry of the Environment and the Energy Transition)

Policy change:

Regional Operational Programme (ROP), Romania

Implementation of electronic ticketing systems:

- cities are eligible to **implement integrated ticketing systems** for a wider, regional area in partnership with neighbouring towns/villages that are part of the functional metropolitan area
- more benefits in terms of efficiency and **CO2 reductions** than local systems limited to the geographic boundaries of one city

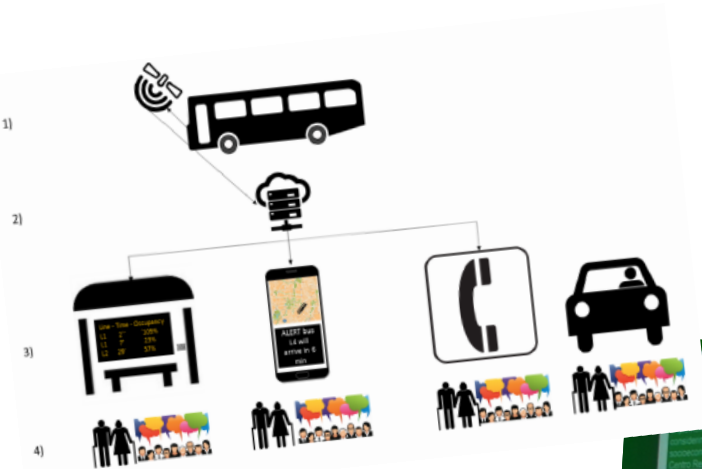

Programme's first pilot action approved in March 2018



Participation in the cooperation forum, Sofia (2018)



What about the future?



- May 2018: Interreg Europe not present in the EC draft proposal for 2021-2027: **pan European interregional cooperation seemed no longer possible!**
- Since then: negotiation with EP and Council who asked for Interreg Europe to be back
- To be continued.... (finalisation of regulation, budget decision)
