The whole history of Burgas is connected with the sea.

Since 18<sup>th</sup> century Burgas is the most important port in the south of Bulgaria.





# Industrialization of the city



During the first decades of the 20<sup>th</sup> century Burgas go through rapid development in the industry.

More than 150 industrial factories were created, it was built an oil refinery.

Today Burgas is an important industrial, commercial, cultural and tourist centre.

# Public access area of Port of Burgas



For many years the free access to the port of Burgas was forbidden because of industrial development.



Public access area was separated since 2014.



# Public access area of Port of Burgas



It provides entrance to the yacht port, traffic tower for vessel control, passenger terminal and the renovated warehouse which will be turned into cultural centre.





# “Magazia”\* (Renovated warehouse)



The building was renovated in 2016.

Fully preserved structure of the roof – “Eiffel” type

The marine centre will serve the passengers who use the services of the offshore sailing

*Old warehouse for tobacco 1962*

*\*Store place at customs, stations and others. Storage of goods and shipments.*





In the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century Burgas has connections by land, air and sea – Burgas airport was built and the port was modernized

On June 29<sup>th</sup> 1947 Burgas was “discovered and open” by air.

During the 50s and 60s the airport was expanded and modernized. In 1970 Burgas Airport obtains international status.

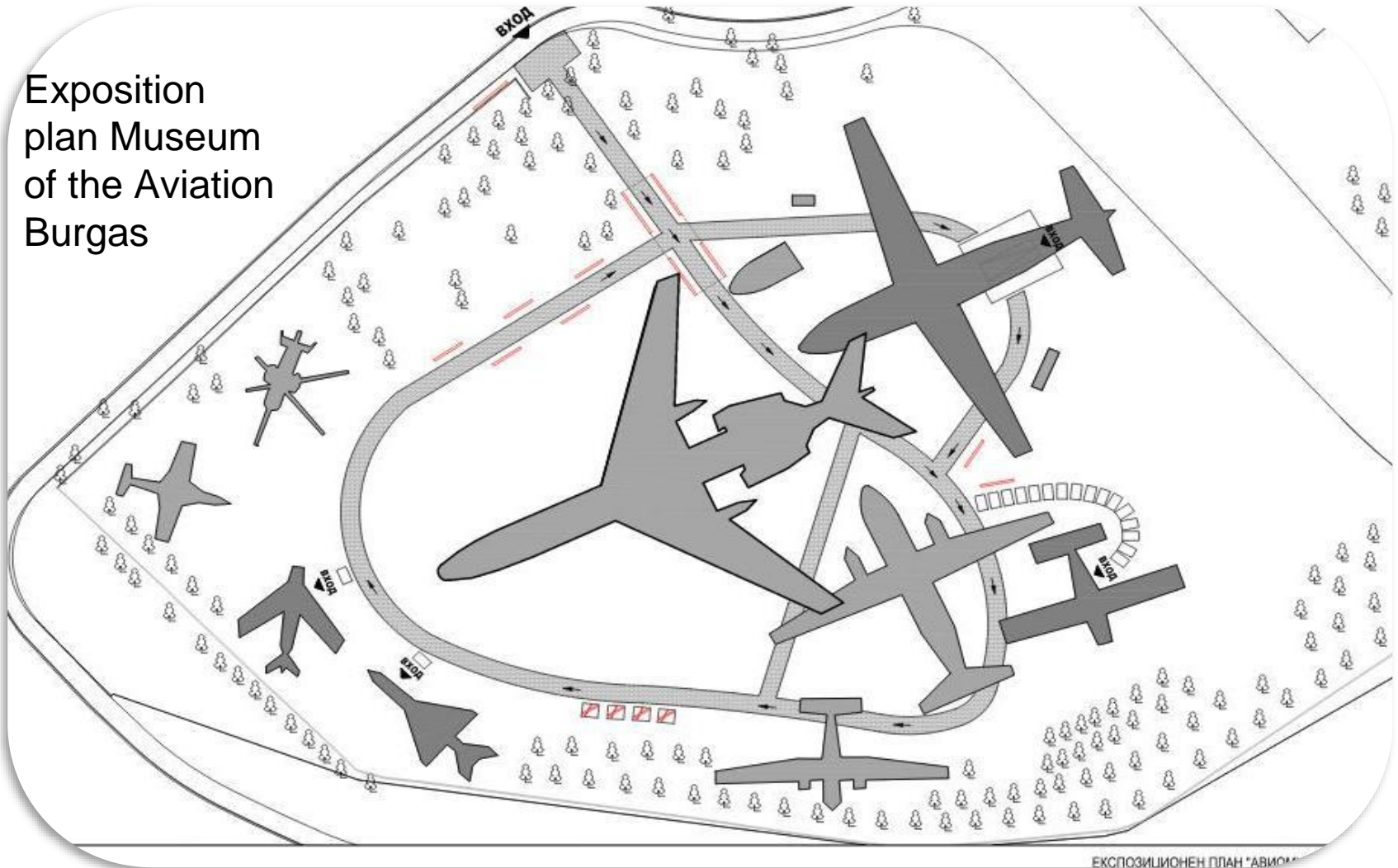
