# Policy Instrument: INTERREG A Germany-Netherland

- Introduced in 1991
- covering an area from the Wadden Sea to the Lower Rhine, along a 460-kilometre-long border
- For 2014-2020: 
   € 222 million ERDF funding;
   total programme budget > € 453 million
- More than 1700 partners in projects, of which more than 1300 SMEs





### Action Plan Implementation

#### 28/06/19: Presentation of Action Plan at the Monitoring Committee

- Consists of all INTERREG Partners (e.g. Dutch Ministry of Economic Affairs, Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy, Ministry for Economy, Innovation, Digitalisation and Energy North Rhine-Westphalia)
- Monitors the implementation of the programme
- highest decision-making body in the programme
- members meet two to three times a year to take fundamental decisions on the programme and its implementation



#### **Presentation of Action Plan at the Preparation Committee**

- Representatives of the INTERREG Partners have started to meet regularly to prepare INTERREG VI A DE-NL Programme
- Programme to be finalised within the next few months

# Making sustainability a scoring criterion for the assessment of project applications


- New Programme Priority "Greener Europe" selected: stronger focus on sustainability
- No projects without fulfilling sustainability criterion; will become essential scoring criterion







# Reducing the duration for the approval processes for new project applications



- Preparation Committee acknowledges the fact that the approval process takes too long which can deter possible applicants
- Working on a method to speed up the approval process and reduce bureaucratic burden
- Working group on digitalization and simplification of processes for the application and implementation of projects
- Benchmark: 18 to 20 weeks



#### Improving Communication and branding of the Interreg DE-NL

- Preparation Committee acknowledges the fact that improved communication in necessary
- Currently working on an extensive communication strategy;
   new branding of Interreg Germany-Netherlands programme website has already been done





# 'Cross-border ambassadors' and organising face-to-face events for experienced and new project partners



- Preparation Committee acknowledges the fact that often the same partners do several Interreg Projects and explicitly express the will to include new partners
- Currently working on a strategy on how to involve partners who have not been (lead) partners in Interreg Projects before
