DATE: 18th OCTOBER

Mr. Angelo Sbrocca, Mayor of Termoli Municipality has welcomed everybody and opened the meeting. Then he gave the floor to Mr. Adolfo Colagiovanni, HERICOAST' Project Manager from Molise Region, who also welcomed everybody and gave a brief and quick overview about the HERICOAST' agenda, the scheduled activities and expected results for the interregional meeting.

Mr. Dirk Gotzmann, from CIVILSCAPE, took the floor and showed the deadline of activities foreseen in current semester, than he invited all project partners to illustrate the development of their regional action plan. Each partner delivered a presentation about current status of its action plan, as follows:

- Vest-Agder County Council
- Donegal County Council
- Lea Artibai Development Agency
- Tulcea County Council
- Castilla y Leon Regional Government
- Molise Region

At the end of presentations, Mrs. Martine Zoeterman, from CLUE+ - Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam presented the toolbox and the deadline of project' activities.





Subsequently the discussion began among Project Partners for 1st round of chapters in 4 working groups, in particular addressing the following issues:

- Group A: Taking a coastal heritage approach
- Group B: Citizen investment payback
- GroupC: Public-private partnerships
- Group D: High-scale policies

The discussion was about how to finalise writing of chapter and revision of good practises before end of October.

At the end of the first round, each groups' representative showed the results of the table'discussion and shared with the other groups the decisions taken to finalise the chapter (*ask to all tables' coordinators to send the minutes to attach*).

DATE: 19th OCTOBER

The day started with the 4th steering group meeting attended by the project partners. Stakeholders were invited to attend a study visit to Termoli historic centre.

After the steering group meeting Mr. Dirk Gotzmann from CIVILSCAPE, gave a feedback from Marinescape Forum in Poole, held on 16th – 17th May 2017 and underlined the importance of European Cultural Heritage publication for HERICOAST Project. He presented the Marinescape Forum in Burgas, to be held on 29th – 30th May 2018, as well. In that occasion all project partners will present their best practices. Furthermore he said that during the international conference for anniversary (10 years of activities) of CIVILSCAPE in 2018, will be presented HERICOAST Project.

Mr. Gotzmann spoke about Policy Learning Platform and integration of the toolbox, then he gave the floor to Mrs. Martine Zoeteman for a feedback on academic events in Portugal and Finland, attended by University of Amsterdam.

The session was closed at 12:30.

After the Steering Group meeting, Mr. Dirk Gotzmann took interviews from each Project Partner to upload on the Interreg Europe website.

After lunch partner and stakeholders attended the study visit to Molise Region' best practices, located on the coast (Campomarino, Petacciato and Termoli).

The group visited the Environmental Educational Centre of Petacciato. Mrs. Sara Fusco explained to the participants the activities of the Centre: workshops for students, preservation and research activities, meetings.

Mr. Michele Macchiagodena presented the good practice **Costa dei Delfini**, a territorial tourism marketing project that involves four municipalities of the Molise coast (Termoli, Campomarino, Montenero di Bisaccia, Petacciato) and five inland (San Martino in Pensilis, San Giacomo degli Schiavoni, Portocannone, Guglionesi and Montecilfone), to create a new strategy based on

the enhancement of the coastal heritage, on the professionalism of the tourism sector entrepreneurs and on the promotion of quality food and wine products, through the creation of a brand, registered at national level.





Then the participants visited Campomarino and Petacciato coasts, sites of Community Interest, related to **LIFE MAESTRALE**, a practice upon management of the environmental heritage and protection of coastal dunes that involved the Municipality of Petacciato, the Municipality of Campomarino and the University of Molise, to mitigate the negative effects of human pressure on coastal dunes and to preserve dunal habitats.

Mrs Federica Roscioni, from University of Molise explained the actions undertaken to valorise and recover the naturalistic heritage of these areas, promoting good practices among coastal managers and users, as well as training, dissemination activities and environmental education with the aim of raising ecological awareness and encouraging proper management of dune habitats.

At the end of the visit the group viewed the boardwalk related to the good practice **Sistemazione naturalistica e restauro di aree dunali compromesse**, that involved the Municipality of Termoli, the Molise Region and the Port Authority in order to monitor the current impact on the dunal ecosystems and to promote biodiversity.

During the field visit Molise region also presented information related to the good practices of Molise Orientale Tourist District, Albergo Diffuso and Trabucchi e pescherecci.

The **Albergo Diffuso** project is geared towards sustainable tourism and respect for the environment, in order to enhance the small historic centers, the ancient villages and rural and mountain settlements of our region. The project aims to create a receptive model that can improve local hospitality features by coordinating socioeconomic activities also through the implementation of national and foreign tourism development strategies. Staying in an Albergo Diffuso means living the village and the territory, knowing the lifestyle of the place, savoring its natural, historical, culinary and folkloristic features. Actions have been taken to recover the heritage, not only real estate but also cultural and social, as well as training activities for tour operators involved in the project. The Albergo Diffuso and hospitality in the villages can represent a model of revaluation of the territory, to prevent depopulation of small villages, renewing and strengthening the local socioeconomic structure.

The project of the **Molise Orientale Tourist District** is based on the enhancement of the material and immaterial cultural heritage of the Molise Coast as the basis for the tourist attraction.

The aim of the project is to share a common strategic plan for heritage conservation and tourism development, involving both public and private stakeholders. In particular, the strategic plan provides for: a territorial analysis of the area and a specific list of lines of action for proper economic management to be pursued together with local stakeholders. The Molise Region's policy development

processes on coastal and river landscape management are closely linked to the development of the Molise Orientale tourism district for the definition of a governance model, based on landscape management, heritage conservation and the development of a sustainable tourism.

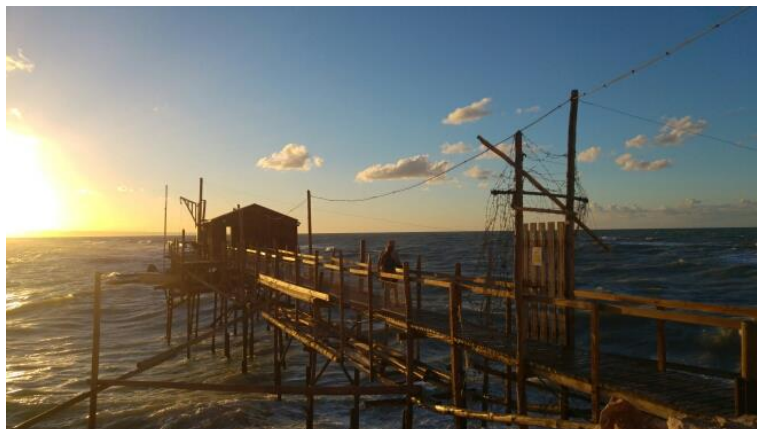

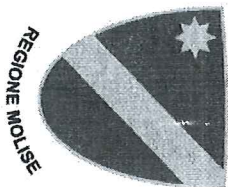

Trabucchi e pescherecci is part of the wider initiative "Natural...mente sulla costa molisana" that was launched in 2013 to propose sustainable tourism events combining the enhancing of the natural resources with the exploitation of the coast especially in the summer. From 2015 to today the municipalities of Petacciato, Montenero di Bisaccia, Termoli and Campomarino joined the initiative proposing a shared calendar of



summer activities, with guided tours, nature tours and didactic workshops, carried out in collaboration with researchers from the University of Molise and professionals in the area. Specifically, for the city of Termoli, through the guided tours of the "Trabucco di Celestino" and on the pier of a port on board a fishing vessel for small fisheries, activities of enhancing local maritime culture were carried out with the rediscovery and the usability of a cultural and environmental heritage often forgotten. Furthermore basic knowledge of the fisheries supply chain has been disseminated, for the promotion and development of sustainable fisheries.

The study visit ended at 18.30.
