- Connecting Living Labs in the areas of health, agro-food, resilient society & smart city/neighborhoods
















## Helium ambition BPD - in short

## Idea behind Transnational Living Lab

- Demonstrating value of Living Labs as validation tool
- Promoting end-user involvement and co-creation for success
  - Products & services should be better aligned to needs
  - Improving market uptake
- Promoting access to new markets & smoother introduction to new markets
  - Flanders/Belgium & South Netherlands/Netherlands relatively small markets
  - Challenges are not limited to individual markets!








# Moving forwards – operational level
