SU HSMTC introduction:

- Semmelweis University is one of the oldest universities in Hungary
- Health Services Management Training Centre (HSMTC) is one of the youngest, dynamic departments (established in 20 April 1995)
- aim: to assist to the development of health services in Hungary and on international level by generating better management knowledge and practice

SU HSMTC – learning opportunities:

- *MSc in Health Services Management*
- *PhD*
- *short programmes*: the aim is to provide practical skills, further training or specialized training. The topics include for instance the management of DRGs, PR and marketing in health care, managing quality in health services organisations, etc.
- *graduate education*

SU HSMTC – development opportunities:

- *management development programmes for hospitals:* to assist the management team of hospitals in their development or change efforts
- *planning and managing change programmes:* to provide practical assets, theoretical basics and process support for effective change management
- *consulting activities:* to give assistance for managers and decision makers in various areas of health policy, organisational management and management education development

SU HSMTC – international cooperation (1):

- member of several international professional organisations, like the European Health Management Association (EHMA) and the European Health Property Network (EUHPN)
- strong collaboration with the World Bank and the World Health Organisation
- WHO Collaborating Centre on Human Resources for Health – since December 2015 → contributes to the efforts of the WHO technical programme on Human Resources for Health in capacity building for strengthening health workforce in Member States to address the goals of Health 2020

SU HSMTC – international cooperation (2):

- member of EIT Health (EIT = European Institute of Innovation and Technology)
 - consortium of more than 50 core partners and 90 associate partners from leading businesses, research centres and universities from across 14 EU countries
 - goal is to contribute to increasing the competitiveness of European industry, improve the quality of life of Europe's citizens and the sustainability of healthcare system
 - delivering products, concepts and services, including educational programmes

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (1):

- Creating the Hungarian Centre of Excellence for Molecular Medicine (MOLMEDEX)
 - *coordinated by Hungary and funded by H2020*
 - *compiling a business plan for the Centre of Excellence*
 - *contributing in WP2 (Market analysis - network analyses based on mining publicly available publication, project and management controlled databases) and WP7 (Sustainability – Business plan)*

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (2):

- Joint Action on Health Workforce Planning and Forecasting
 - *coordinated by Belgium and funded by the third EU Health Programme*
 - *compiling recommendations on workforce planning in the health sector*
 - *WP4 leader – Data for improved Health Workforce Planning - aims at improving the quality and comparability of health workforce data*

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (3):

- SH/8/1 - Public Health Focused Model Programme for organising primary care services backed by a Virtual Care Service Centre
 - *to expand the preventive services of primary care by the establishment of the so called “GP clusters”*
 - *research programs (health status surveillance, epidemiological surveys, etc)*
 - *establishment of a new IT system for the GP cluster)*

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (4):

- Supporting Public Procurement Innovative Solutions (ECOQUIP)
 - *to improve the efficiency, quality and environmental sustainability of healthcare through innovation procurement*
 - *to stimulate demand for innovative goods and services and delivering practical procurement outcomes*

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (5):

- Joint Action to support the eHealth Network (JAseHN)
 - *coordinated by Austria and funded by the third EU Health Programme*
 - *acting as the main preparatory body for the eHealth Network*
 - *developing political recommendations and other instruments for cooperation*
 - *WP2 leader – Dissemination and Communication – ensuring the clear and timely communication and data flow among and beyond the project members*

SU HSMTC – international activities / running projects (6):

- Good Practices for demonstrating safety and quality through recipient follow-up (Euro-GTP II)
 - *coordinated by Spain and funded by the third EU Health Programme*
 - *focusing on the technical requirements needed to assess the quality and safety of novel Tissue and Cell (T&C) and demonstrate their efficacy through clinical validation data and recipient follow-up*
 - *contributing in WP3 (Evaluation), WP5 (Generic Good Practices for demonstrating safety and quality through recipient follow up) and WP9 (T&C Database and Interactive assessment tool)*

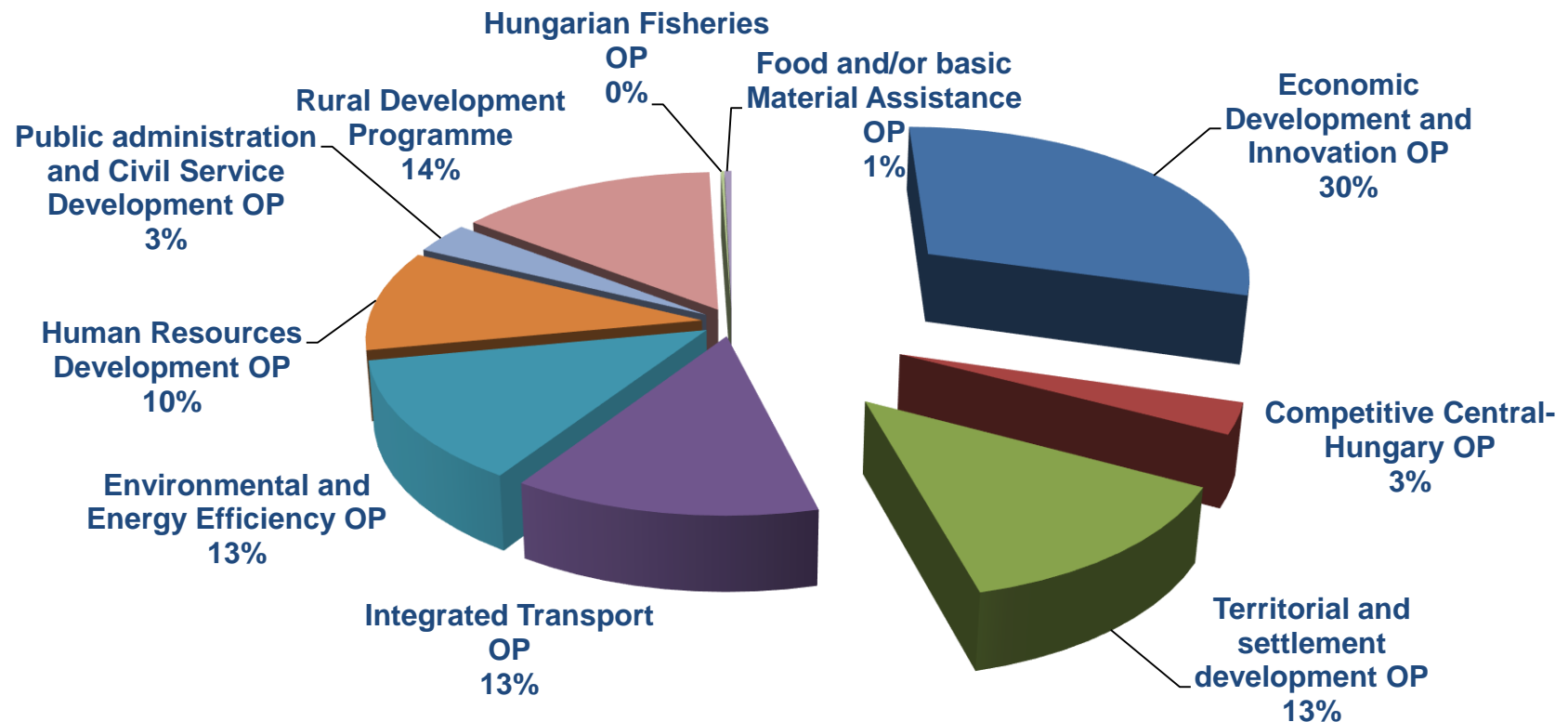
HELIUM – HSMTC's main tasks:

- responsible for the TF „Uptake of innovation” (set up and manage in line with the joint methodology)
- carrying out regional analysis → assessing strengths and weaknesses through workshops, interviews, surveys based on a joint methodology
- „Let's-Blend-It” interregional seminar (in Budapest, M17)
- preparing work plan for staff exchanges (M19-M21)
- HU partners: preparing action plans + set up a peer-review group
- communication and dissemination activity:
 - *general tasks (running project website, disseminate the project)*
 - *7th event – Final Dissemination event (Phase I or Phase II?)*

Economic Development and Innovation Operational Programme 2014-2020:

- aims to stimulate the economies of the less developed regions in Hungary
- most important priorities are:
 - increasing the competitiveness of small-and medium sized enterprises
 - developing research and innovation
 - boosting employment
 - promoting the tourism industry, enterprises' energy efficiency, and information and communication technologies
 - stimulating the use of financial instruments

Economic Development and Innovation Operational Programme 2014-2020:

- the project will focus on priority axes 2 (research, technology development and innovation) and 8 (financial instruments)
- through the projects recommendations will be made:
 - finetuning of selection criteria and eligibility rules in calls
 - introducing additional measures/incentives in calls
 - organising and sequencing of calls
 - improvement of monitoring procedures
 - improving consultation mechanisms and stakeholder involvement during preparation of calls
