RDA Centru, RO (PP10)

- RDA Centru (PP10) is a Romanian regional agency, responsible for regional planning and development in Centru Region.
- RDA Centru also acts as Intermediate Body for the Regional Operational Programme 2014-2020.
- In the next programming period RDA Centru will act as Managing Authority for the Regional Operational Programme 2021-2027.





ROP 2014-2020 - ERDF



- ROP 2014-2020 aims to increase the overall economic competitiveness and improve the living conditions of local and regional communities by supporting the development of the business environment, infrastructure and services for the sustainable development of the regions so that they can effectively manage resources and capitalize on their potential for innovation and assimilation of technological progress.
- > Within 2014/2020 ROP was a national program with regional financial allocations;
- > 13 priority axes

3.1.A – Residential buildings




Eligibile activities:

- The introduction of renewable energy sources
- Replacement of fluorescent and incandescent lighting bulbs
- Implementation of power management systems
- Developing strategies for energy efficiency

Eligible applicants:

Administrative-territorial units from the urban areas in partnership with owner associations


3.1.B – Public buildings


Eligibile activities:

- Improvement of thermal insulation and waterproofing the roof, consolidation measures
- Modernization of the heating system
- The introduction of renewable energy sources, including biomass
- Replacement of fluorescent and incandescent lighting bulbs
- Implementation of power management systems
- Developing strategies for energy efficiency

Eligible applicants:

Central/local public authorities, as well as public institutions













3.1.C – Public lighting

Eligibile activities:

- Purchase and installation of public lighting telemanagement systems
- Replacing high-energy consumption lighting bulbs with high energy efficiency LEDs
- $\circ~$ Use of renewable energy sources
- Rehabilitation of electrical installations pillars, grids, etc.
- Creating and extending the public lighting system in urban areas

Eligible applicants:

 Administrative-territorial units in the urban area

Overview of ROP 3.1B implementation



- The call for projects under this operation was opened in 2017 (February, 28 –October, 4). Applicants from urban and rural public authorities, local and national authorities and institutions could apply for funding.
- Thermal rehabilitation of public buildings built up until the end of 1999 with a total useful floor area of more than 250 m² were targeted. The total eligible amount of a grant application was of at least 100.000 Euro and a maximum of 25 mil Euro, the applicants' contribution being of at least 2%. The financial allocation for the Centru Region was 46,45 mil Euro

AIM





- Improve ROP 2014-2020, P.I. 3.1 "Supporting energy efficiency, smart energy management and the use of energy from renewable sources in public infrastructures, including in public buildings, and in the housing sector.
- Ensure better implementation of RIS3 Centru Sustainable Built Environment Priority and create the premises for cooperation between stakeholders, promote knwolege and GPs transfer



Results of BIO4ECO implementation



- GPs dissemination => Better quality of the projects submitted under ROP 3.1
- RDA Centru drafted two letters containing recommendations for improving ROP 2014-2020, PA 3.1 & requested a redistribution of the existing funds and the relaunch of a call for proposals under ROP 2014-2020, Pl 3.1 => a new call was launched
- Increased cooperation between regional stakeholders and with interregional organisations => more involvement in drafting the future programming period ROP 2021/2027
- Increased budget allocated for EE (proposed 91.6 mil Euro -ERDF) within ROP 2021/2027
