

## French Forest municipalities :

- 1/3 of communes forest owners
- Total area : 2,9 M ha
- 16 % of the total forest area
- 8 million m<sup>3</sup>/ year harvesting (20 m<sup>3</sup>/ year for FR)
- 61 % of public forests
- 11 000 municipalities (communes)








- Unique public establishment for the management of state forests : Office National des Forêts (National Forestry Office)
- Three main property status : state owned, municipality owned of privately owned
- Concerning municipality owned forests
  - : the mayor is the final decision maker








#### Effects of Covid-19 crisis in forest & wood sector in France

## Learned lessons and developed tools

- Un existing ressource partially exploited by local forest-wood industry
- Industrial requirements heavily dependants on softwood supplies



• Forest and wood sector in the center of biodiversity and climate policies



- Promotion of certification marks and European labels
- Development of local strategies bringing together all forest and wood stakeholders
- Support to public forest owners with specific commercial tools
