







- May 2018: Interreg Europe not present in the EC draft regulations
- May 2019: EP and Council asked for Interreg Europe to be back
- December 2019: start of the programming process

- To be continued.... (finalisation of regulation, budget decision)

Key features remain:

- 1. Pan-European
- 2. Similar overall objective
- Regional development policy makers as core target groups
- 3. Similar means to achieve the objective
- Main focus on capacity building
- 1. Focus on Structural Funds lightened
- 2. Learning by doing: pilot actions
- Proposals: 3
 - 3. Only one single priority in the programme : capacity building.
