| Background | Firms operating waste plants need authorization for renewal permit or for renewal of inscription in the Register for waste management. |
| Detailed description of the measure | Firms operating waste plants can provide autocertification for authorization renewal or for renewal of inscription in the Register for waste management. The autocertification must be provided to competent authorities and is considered de facto a substitute for the authorization. It applies to EMAS, Ecolabel and ISO14001 companies that manage waste plants |
