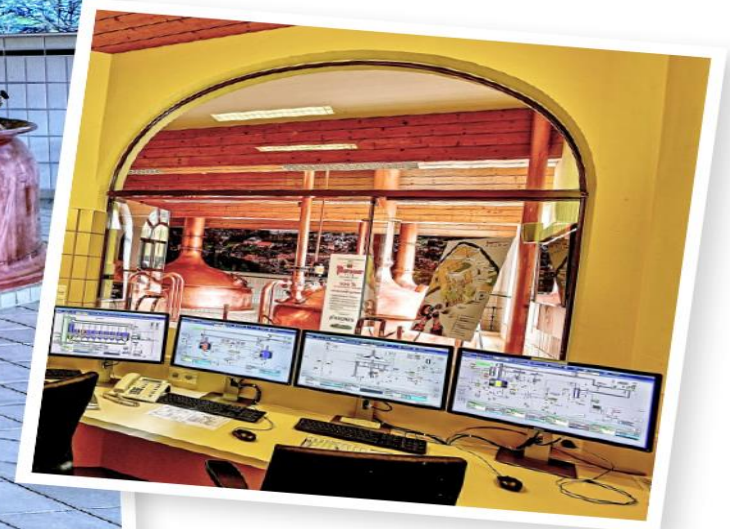


Evaluation criterias for the Environmental statements for the EMAS award

- 1. Environmental management system: clarity and importance of environmental policy, legal certainty, traceability of the structure and process of the organization (max 5 points)
- 2. Environmental aspects and environmental impacts: identification, evaluation, transparency of the presentation (max 5 points)
- 3. Environmental performance, environmental program and environmental goals: indicators, comprehensibility, traceability (max 5 points)
- 4. Communication (internal / external), employee involvement, graphic design and design of the environmental Statement (max 5 points)

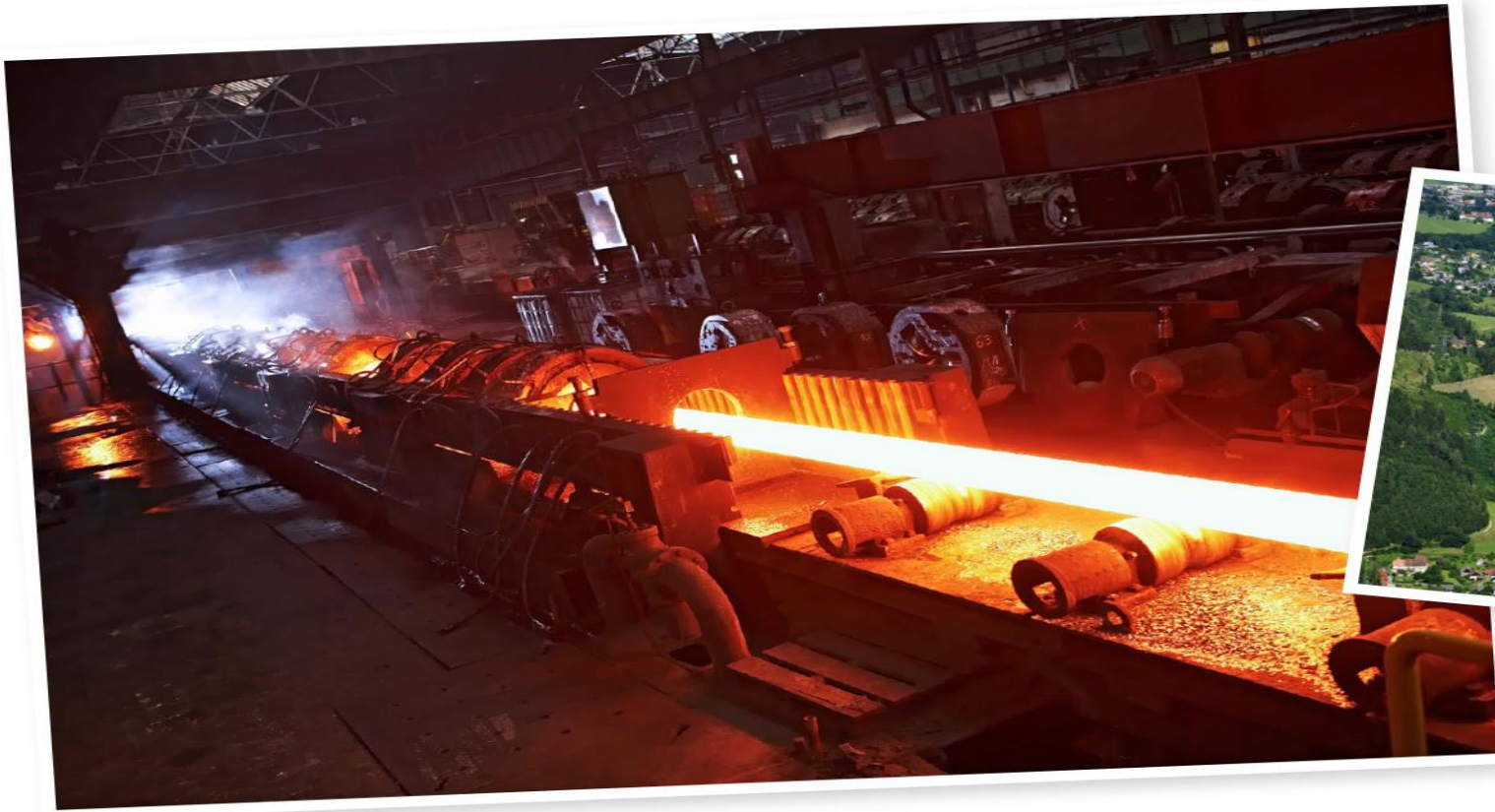
