

REPORTING PROCEDURES in Andalusia (1/2)

- Business Plan for packaging and waste prevention
- Monitoring of the Business Plan (before 31st March of each year)
- Plan of waste minimisation (1 every 4 year)
- Annual Declaration for hazardous waste producers
- Annual Declaration for non-hazardous waste producers
- Annual Declaration for decontamination and disposal of equipment containing PCBs
- Annual notification for the P-RTR register (if applicable)
- Annual Declaration for packaging









REPORTING PROCEDURES in Andalusia (1/2)

- Notification for waste transfer (1 per transfer)
- Notification for waste transfer among regions (1 per transfer)
- Notification for waste transfer among Member States (1 per transfer)
- Notification for oil waste collection (1 per collection)
- Notification for hazardous waste collection (1 per collection)
- Annual report for electric and electronic waste managers
- Annual information about management of municipal waste
- Annual report for electric and electronic waste managers
- Annual information about management of municipal waste
- Summary Report for managers of end-of-life vehicles waste

POTENCIAL initiatives in Andalusia for WASTES

- Waste Electric and Electronic equipments (EEE)
- Adjustment of authorisations for electric and electronic waste managers
- Needs Studies of over 200 clean points (on-site visits all facilities)
- Waste end-of-life vehicles (ELV)
 - Adjustment of authorisations for end-of-life vehicles waste managers
- Collaboration Agreements of CMAOT
 - FAMP ECOEMES: general requirements to apply in Councils
 - FAMP 9 Collective Systems of EEE operating in Andalusia
 - Suppliers of EEE: properly management of WEEE
 - CMAOT FAMP Collective Systems: improve the collection, store and valorisation of of batteries and accumulators waste
 - (*) FAMP: Spanish Federation of Municipalities and Provinces







