

Main guidelines for the cycle network design




- Segregation from motorised traffic
- Connectivity between the main trip attractors and the main residential areas
- Continuity, with no gaps along it
- Homogeneity, with uniform pavement and design
- Rapid construction, generating an effective "word of mouth" effect

Evolution of number of bicycle journeys in Seville 2006-2011





Evolution in Seville of modal split of mechanical trips and of all kind of trips (figures in parentheses)

	Walk	Bicycle	Public Transport	Car	Motorbike
1990	(46.7)%	1.1 (0.6)%	46.0 (24.5)%	46.7 (24.9)%	6.2 (3.3)%
2007	(36.5)%	5.0 (3.2)%	30.7 (19.5)%	57.2 (36.3)%	7.1 (4.5)%
2009	(37.1)%	6.6 (4.1)%	32.5 (20.5)%	52.8 (33.2)%	8.1 (5.1)%
2011	(36.7)%	8.9 (5.6)%	34.8 (22.2)%	48.3 (30.5)%	8.0 (5.0)%

# 3. Seville experience

- From 0,6% to 9% between 2006 and 2011
- 13 Km bike paths
- 72.000 commuting by bike
- 20.000 less commuting by car
- A reduction of 8.000 tons of CO2 per year








## 3. Seville experience
