In 1991 the average EU citizen bought 34 garments in a year, in 2007 that had risen to 67 (one every 4-5 days) 2 billion pairs of jeans are produced globally each year

> On average, it takes 7,000 litres of water to make one pair of jeans

> > It takes 2,700 litres of water to make one T shirt

Over 8,000 different synthetic chemicals are used to turn raw materials into




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RESET Project Rationale
