

#### Beginning 2020 → PANDEMIC situation

- COMPETE approved the extension of projects (between 6 and 12 months)
  - → most of the actions haven't finished (or just finish)
- The impossibility to get values (at this time) to fill the indicators planned for the project
- COMPETE launched additional **R&D + Innovation** calls
  - → to fight COVID19
  - → high participation of T&C companies
    - . 9 Innovation projects
    - . 6 R&D projects



18 T&C companies 7 of them 1st time

#### **Conclusions**



➤ RESET project has been an important tool to increase the participation of SME companies in sustainable R&D activities.



- Good Practices presented in brainstorms, aligned with the interests of Portuguese Textile Cluster and companies, allowed to boost new R&D + Innovation ideas and opportunities that were converted in proposals
  - Most of them, converted into new Portuguese R&D projects, under the policy instrument Portugal2020
  - Ohers, converted in others EU opportunities...

Portuguese T&C Industry increased the participation rate in Portugal 2020 policy, either in R&D activities as also in Innovation activities, bring more innovation to this industry making proof of the importance of this Policy instrument, influencing it for the next framework
