INVESTMENT PRIORITY 6d- Protecting and restoring biodiversity and soil and promoting ecosystem services, including through Natura 2000, and green infrastructure





SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE: 6.1 Investments in Green and Blue infrastructure and actions that support the provision of ecosystem services on which businesses and communities depend to increase local natural capital and support sustainable economic growth





By 2023

- **1500 ha** GI
- 30ha of rehabilitated land
- 2113ha of habitats supported to attain better conservation status (Natura 2000 sites)


New Anglia LEP have a target of **500ha** of wild space to be created **by 2020**



2.8% of ERDF funding goes to objective 6 NEW Anglia LEP receive £40 million
