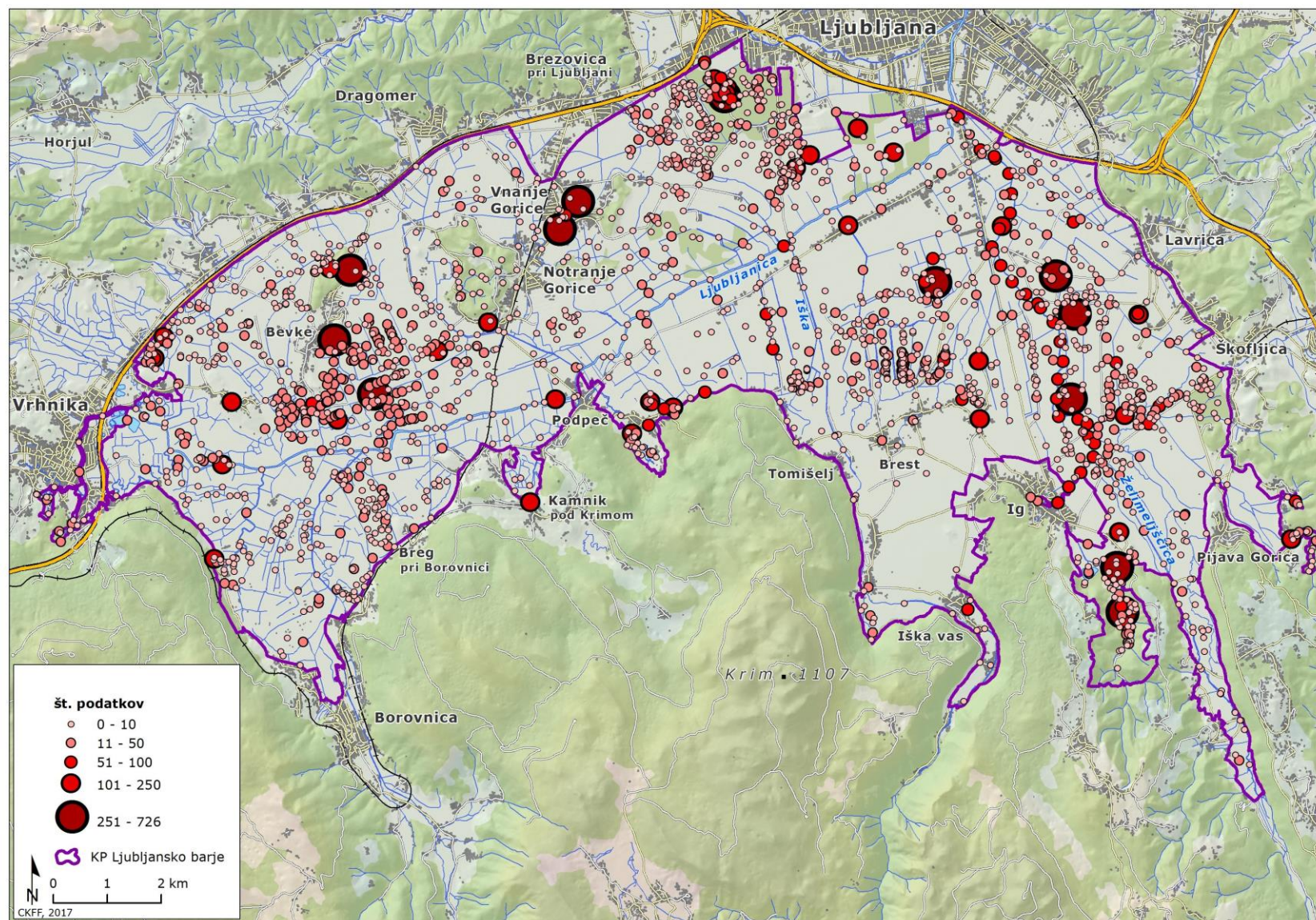


20 years of data gathering at Ljubljana Moor - recollections and lessons

What does it represent?

Data

- Public (reports, monitorings) - 43%
- Written (published, „grey“ literature) - 16%
- Personal/private (data of collaborators outside CKFF) - 41%

Lessons

- Data gathering is not a sprint but rather a **marathon**
