## **OBJECTIVE**



BID- REX aims to improve the use of biodiversity information and increase the impact of regional development policies for preservation of the European natural heritage by providing decision-making processes with appropriate biodiversity information.



# **OBJECTIVE**



## Sub-objectives (1/2):

- Identify regional specific strengths and weaknesses in the current uses of biodiversity data
- Identify, exchange and implement good practices and techniques related to biodiversity information management and use at different stages in the decision processes
- Improve local governance by creating and improving discussion forums and by developing synergies and coordinating missions among regional actors

# **OBJECTIVE**



## Sub-objectives (2/2):

- Increase of the technical capacities of the regional actors when managing structured biodiversity information and data flows
- Improve the workflows leading to effective decision making and prioritization to ensure better and more efficient regional development policies, particularly ERDF funds investment allocation
- Enhance the social acceptance & credibility of the decision processes derived from the use of objective and reliable information


