In collaboration with OGS, ISPRA & IOF we designed 4 Questionnaires, 3 of them targeting to Stakeholders and one to the general public














#### **Stakeholders Profile**





## Which do you consider are the main barriers and bottlenecks to evaluate GES?




According to your experience in pollution management, priority should be given to:







#### Data availability & sharing

How often do you look for (need) contaminants data?








~87 % are in need of data

#### **EIA** studies


Main gaps towards harmonization of EIA protocols in the ADRION region

Low coherence in impacts analysis and assessments considered in each country

> Lack of consistency in authorization procedure actions

High discrepancy of national legislation



> > Lack of access to data






## EIA studies Gaps & Difficulties

EIA studies are essential in tackling marine pollution


Yes; 95.5%


#### Not enough is being done regarding pollution accidents in ADRION countries




Most of them think that both forecasting/prevention and emergency/cleanups can be improved

#### Main gaps for pollution risk assessment








#### HarmoNIA products
