Offshore HC production and worked hours (Italy, 2018)


Working hours in the offshore upstream installations: 3,669,101 h


Total offshore HC production: 3,311 kTOE









MAPS OF THE OFFSHORE INSTALLATIONS IN IN THE ITALIAN SIDE OF THE ADRIATIC


Location of the offshore installations: Adriatic sea vs other locations (Italy, 2018)




Location of the offshore installations: Northern Adriatic (Italian side)

The **Committee for Safety of Offshore operations [CSOO]** is the Italian Competent Authority according to Legislative Decree (n. 145/2015) implementing Directive "Offshore" (Directive 2013/30/EU)

The "Offshore Committee" has a multi-body structure.

The **President** of the Italian C.A. is an **independent expert** appointed by the President of the Council of Ministers.

The Italian CSOO is composed of representatives of:

- DGS- UNMIG National Mining Office for Hydrocarbons and Georesources
 (Ministry of Economic Development);
- Ministry of Environment, Land and Sea;
- Coast Guard;
- National Firefighting Corp;
