

- May 2018: Interreg Europe not present in the draft regulations
- May 2019: comeback thanks to EP and Council
- December 2019: start of the programming process
- September 2020: first draft of the Cooperation Programme available
- To be continued... (approval expected in September 2021)

No revolution...but evolution

Key features remain:

- 1. Pan-European
- 2. Similar overall objective: Regional development policy makers as core target groups
- 3. Similar means to achieve the objective: Main focus on capacity building

Proposals:

- 1. Focus on Structural Funds lightened
- 2. Learning by doing: pilot actions
- 3. Only one single priority in the programme to better reflect the core nature of the programme (capacity building)
