

Context – Austrian Remix participation

- Austrian Mineral Resources Plan (AMRP) as a national master plan to secure supply of mineral resources
- Considered "Best Practice Model" by the European Commission, as an example for an active minerals planning policy, i.e. concerning land use issues
- Update planned by mining ministry how can it be improved?
 - Learn from others → Remix

- Format of peer reviews provided good suggestions
 - Stakeholder engagement
 - Role of mining in the broader context of smart specialisation
 - Clusters and circular economy
- Phase 2 Update of Raw Materials Strategy 2030
 - Ibiza video caused government change
 - Delays (2019-2020)
 - New government wanted a less inclusive approach

- Draft available
 - Sustainable supply from Austrian sources
 - Sustainable supply from international sources
 - Smart production, circular economy, new technologies and products
- Process monitoring with stakeholders
