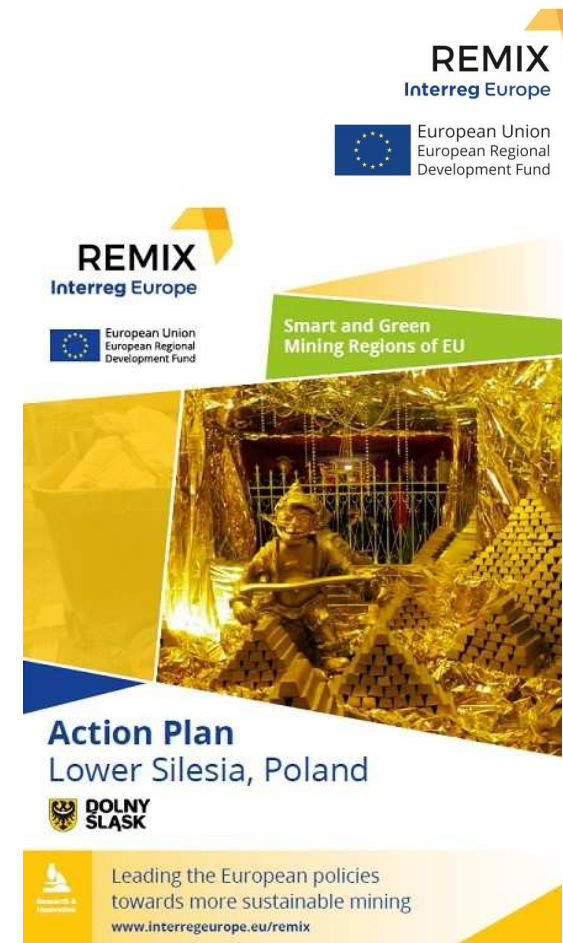

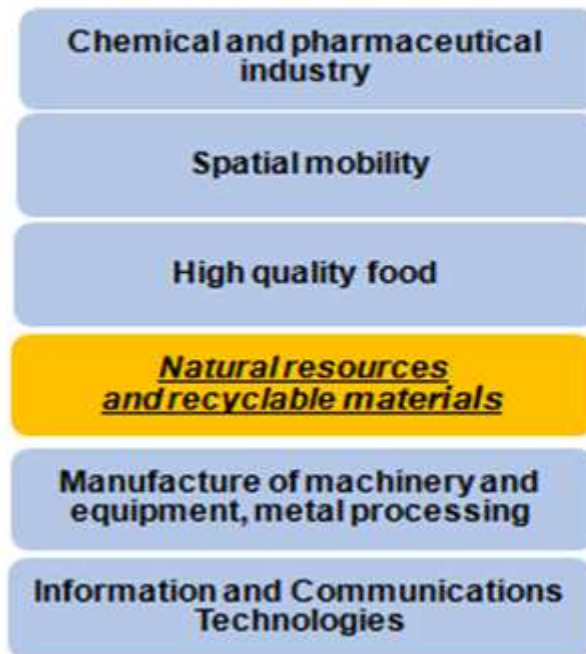

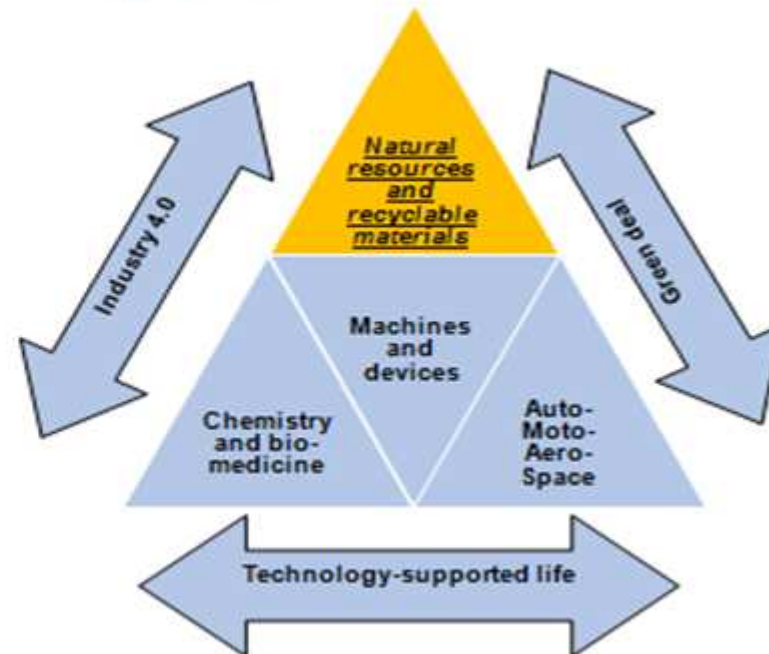


Lower Silesian Innovation Strategy 2030

Supporting projects
