The <u>University of Florence Business Incubator</u> is a structure devoted to disseminate **entrepreneurial skills** within the academic environment and not only, so to support the birth and the first phase of **startups** and **spin-offs development**.

It is managed by <u>CsaVRI</u> (Centre of academic services for the valorisation of research), which promotes the **third mission** of the University: the **valorisation** of the results of academic **research** and **knowledge transfer** for innovation.







- 185 young students or graduates involved






Impresa Campus KPIs

- ✓ networking and team building activities



Pre Incubation Results



From December 2010 until now

- 15 calls for ideas
- 142 projects admitted
- 760 people involved
- more than 80% young (PhD students, PhDs, post-doc, recent graduates)




Pre Incubation KPIs



the conversion rate is about 35%...

- 49 spin-offs
- 10 spin-offs in incubation
- 85% survival rate
- 65% registered as innovative startups (legislation n° 221, 17 December 2012)
- **16%** with Unifi's participation to the equity (up to 15%)
