


Figure 1: Forum of innovative Agriculture on LinkedIn

The project partners added people identified in the stakeholders database developed in MED_Greenhouses project to the Forum, details in the figure below.




Figure 2: participation to the forum

Project partners publish continuously news, articles, events concerning greenhouses and agriculture sector. The activities of the forum are detailed in the figure below.








Figure 3 Activities of the forum




