







## CIVITAS DESTINATIONS OBJECTIVES

- **CIVITAS DESTINATIONS** implements a set of mutually reinforcing innovative mobility solutions in six touristic urban/regional sites
- The project gathers **28 partners** from **12 European countries**, plus **China**
- From **1<sup>st</sup> September 2016** to **31<sup>st</sup> August 2020** (**48 months duration**)
- Total budget of **19.9 M€** of which **17.8 M€** in EC Contribution






