

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

# Job Creation: Results

Cycling means more jobs and an inclusive economy



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## More jobs

Per € million of turnover, the bicycle manufacturing sector employs  
**3 times more people than the car manufacturing sector**

Per € million of turnover, the bicycle sale sector employs  
**More than 4 times more people than the car sale sector**



## Inclusive Europe

The study shows that a number of the jobs do not require high levels of qualification. By providing easily accessible employment for groups that are disadvantaged on the labour market because of their low qualification levels, this offers an opportunity to contribute to the objectives of an inclusive Europe.




# Economic impact of cycle tourism at national level in Germany (2009):

9.2 bn EUR per year  
186'000 jobs

## **Great Western Greenway (Ireland)**
