

AMAre PLUS, through a close collaboration between scientists and MPA Management Bodies, will transfer three highly connected products: 1- the Spatial Geoportal to collect fine scale data on biodiversity status, environmental variables, human pressures and intensity, relevant for management and for distribution exchanging information among MPAs; 2- protocols for ecological monitoring; 3- best practices for the management of human uses and the achievement of the EU legislation goals. The aim is to transfer monitoring/management standards to harmonize the high present Mediterranean heterogeneity characterizing MPAs. contributing to the implementation of an effective MPA network, instrumental to maximize the effects of protection on biodiversity and recommended by EU policies.
