The ISTEN project aims to **improve intermodal connections from Adriatic-Ionian ports to the hinterland**, in particular by supporting rail freight flows and last-mile connections.

## Specific objectives:

- Create a transnational cooperation network to boost innovation and establish a durable cooperation among ADRION ports and intermodal terminals
- Define a common approach and governance model for ADRION integrated hubs

## **Expected results:**

- Improved knowledge on the current bottlenecks towards an integrated hubs network in the ADRION area
- Strengthened cooperation among port and inland infrastructures at local/hub and transnational/network level
- Enhance the competitiveness and environmental sustainability of freight logistics flows across the ADRION area
- Enhanced capacity in planning and organizing intermodal services
