

# Improved Public Transport Information within Scandria®2Act

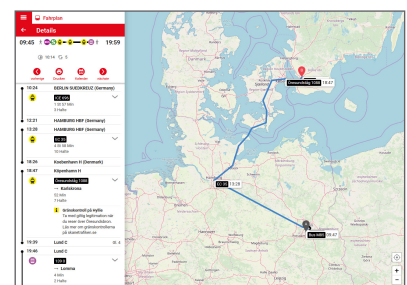


- Cross-border route planning between Berlin-Brandenburg, Copenhagen and Skåne

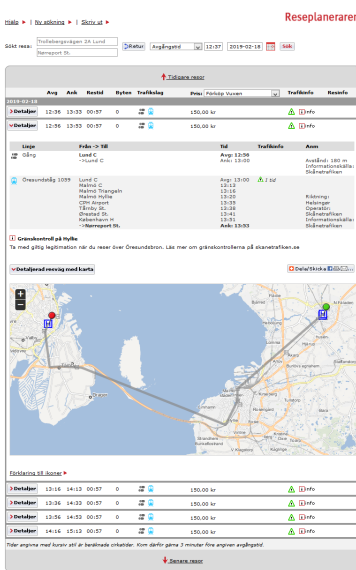


- Within Scandria@2Act Public Transport Authority Berlin-Brandenburg (VBB), Skånetrafiken and Rejseplanen enhanced their travel planning systems, to provide travellers with door-to-door cross-border information services.



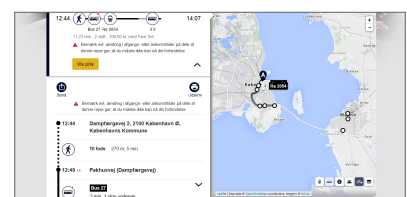
- The technical solution is based on the already existing travel planners and the EU-Spirit network that interlinks the partners' systems. Within Scandria@2Act the partners implemented modular extensions of the IT systems.

- New modules enable the customer to acquire improved route planning, tariff information and possibilities to purchase tickets as well as information on punctuality and disturbances. All solutions can be used on mobile devices.



- Customers will be able to access the services via the systems and user interfaces they are used to.

- The new functionality allows the user also to access ticket booking information with the opportunity to purchase tickets via the partner booking systems.
