Introduction

The Circular PP project was implemented by 10 partners from seven countries from the Baltic Sea Region and the Netherlands between 01/10/2017 until 31/12/2020 (originally the project was supposed to end 30/09/2020, nevertheless it was extended for 6 more months due to the Covid-19, but the partnership decided to finish the project by the end of 2020). The main focus of the project was to use public procurement in the Baltic Sea Region as a catalyst to enhance the market uptake of innovative circular products and services by building capacity among all stakeholders of the value chain (namely procurers, suppliers and policy makers) and introducing the principles of circular economy thinking in the call for tenders in a close feedback dialog with SMEs.

The aim of the following report is to give an overview of all events (related either to circular economy or public procurement) where the project's results were disseminated during the project implementation. The report also summarises the effects and outcomes of what the dissemination brought about.

Task 5.2 Strategic communication with other initiatives on Circular Economy

Task 5.2.1 Events

In addition to the workshops, seminars and capacity building activities organised as part of the Circular PP project, the project team pursued a very active dissemination of the project results among public procurers and companies working to deliver circular products.

For this purpose, two main lines of action were identified:

1. Presentation of results at relevant national and international events with targeted audiences
2. Participation in national and/or international working groups related to circular procurement, to ensure that the project findings are still spread when the project ends.

Project results were presented or partners were participated at around 115 various meetings, events, congresses, where 16 were international, different events related to either circular economy or public procurement. The project partners have reach more than 6.600 persons from public and private sectors, around 400 different companies participating at those events. Originally according to the application form the possibilities to present the project outcomes were to be sought in at least 9 external international events agreed with all partners. Nevertheless, the actual number of events exceeded the plan greatly (please view the Appendix 1). The targets for numbers of different companies was 50. At this target the partner also reach a most higher numbers than planned in the application.

Procurement events

- The project partners took part in procurement events targeted to procurers. Such events were an excellent platform to showcase the project and its achievements, as well as to stimulate the interest of other procurers.
- The project partners presented main project results - the lessons learned report (pilots procurements) and the findings of the research - in front of an audience which is attracted by the topic.
- Partner made own event like the 16 Meet the buyers meetings, the 17 national seminars for procurers, 20 lectures at Universities and the Baltic Circular Procurement Congress. The target for the project was 2 Meet the buyers meetings in each partner countries (in all 14), 2 national seminar for procurers also in each partner countries with at least 10 participants (in all 14 and 140 participants) and 8 lectures. In total more than 2000 people has participated (procurement manager, head of departments, decision makers, SME and other companies, research institutions, NGO and students). 5.2.2 International working groups

This group was relaunched by Circular PP and ICLEI in order to support the dissemination of Circular PP lessons learned to other procurers from across Europe who are conducting or beginning their own circular procurement activities and pilots. The purpose of the group is to supports public authorities to implement sustainable and innovation public procurement,

promote their achievements and foster exchange on good practice from public procurers and experts internationally.

- The first meeting of the Interest Group was held on 29th May 2020. It was planned to take place at the Baltic Circular Procurement Congress in Warsaw, which had to be postponed due to COVID. The Interest Group meeting, however, took place as planned, but online. At this meeting, two best practice cases from the Circular PP project were presented and discussed:
 - Framework for procurement of circular furniture in Malmö – *Emma Börjesson, Project Manager, Environmental Department*
 - Organisational approach to ICT reuse in Aalborg – *Birgitte Krebs Scheeman, Project Manager, Environmental and Energy Department.*
- The second meeting of the Interest Group was held on 26th November 2020, online. Again, a best practice case was presented. Discussion groups were then led by procurers presented their upcoming circular procurement plans for peer review. Contributors included:
 - Best practice presentation – Including CO2 emission criteria in circular procurement – *Klaus Kellerman, City of Roskilde (Denmark)*
 - Upcoming procurement: Pankalampi health care centre demolition project – *Ilkka Liljander, City of Mikkeli (Finland)*
 - Upcoming procurement: Circular vending machines – *Lies De Meyers, Belgian Post (Belgium)*

- Upcoming procurement: Circular ICT devices – *Reeta Huomo, City of Helsinki (Finland)*
- Upcoming procurement: Developing a Circular Procurement Action Plan – *Adriaan Hellemans, City of Apeldoorn (the Netherlands)*
- Upcoming procurement: Circular Procurement Strategy – *Tor Gausemel Kristensen, City of Bodo (Norway)*
- The Circular Procurement Working Group will continue to meet on a bi-annual basis, with the support of the Procura+ Network (an ICLEI initiative). The Interest Group has also been affiliated with the [UN One Planet Network](#) since September 2020.
- Feedback from the first two meetings of the Interest Group has been positive. Procurers appreciate having a space in which they can learn about what has been tried and tested by other contracting authorities, and where they can ask questions and discuss challenges they face. 5.2.3 Other circular procurement related projects

- Several other projects EU funded projects are also currently focused on progressing the circular economy and circular procurement. By establishing communication channels with other projects, it is possible to increase the flow of knowledge between procurers and other professionals working in the circular procurement field, and speed up the rate of learning within this field.

- ProCirc and CircularPP have made several events and meetings together in Denmark. The two projects joined to share experiences of circular tenders with other Danish municipalities and companies at meetings, seminars etc. At the www.circularPP there have been stories related to ProCirc and in the ProCirc newsletter there have been stories related to the CircularPP
 - CircPro: RWS and the Stockholm Environmental Institute (SEI-Tallinn; partner in CircPro) met during the workshop RWS organized at the World Resource Forum in Antwerp (26-2-2019) and decided to stay in touch and seek cooperation. CircPro was invited to organise a workshop at the CPP Baltic Circular Procurement Congress. SYKE has worked together with CircPro
 - Stratkit: RWS participated and gave a presentation in a workshop of Stratkit at the 10th Annual Forum of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region 2019 in Gdansk (13-6-2019). SYKE
 - Ecodesign: RWS and the UBA (German Environment Agency; partner in Ecodesign project) met during the Forum Strategov meeting in St. Petersburg (2-10-2019) and exchanged information on both projects. It was decided to give room to a Ecodesign workshop at the CPP Baltic Circular Procurement Congress.

Conclusions

Over the course of the project, Circular PP project partners - in particular the lead partner City of Aalborg - have participated in a vast number of external events in order to present the project and disseminate the project results. A complete overview is provided in Appendix 1. The target was to host 14 'Meet the buyers' meetings, 14 national seminars for procurers, 8 lectures for students and 1 congress. In addition, the project planned to present on product design at 9 international trade fairs and conferences. In total the partners hosted 16 'meet the buyers' meetings, 17 national seminars, 20 lectures, and presented at 13 international conferences, reaching around 2000 participants.

From the above mentioned numbers, it is clear that the number of events exceeds the plans and expectations set at the beginning of the project. Outreach activity also continued during the Covid-19 situation, as the project team was able to present at many online events.

The tender-pilots which were carried out as part of the project, in particular the two Danish pilots on playgrounds and lifetime extension of ICT equipment, as well as the Swedish tender on non-new furniture, evoked much interest and led to the project receiving many invitations to present its outcomes.

In general, most of the events offered a great opportunity to exchange different experiences with circular public tenders, or gave SMEs a chance to provide their feedback and

recommendations. According to the application form, Circular PP had a target to contact 50 companies. This target was greatly exceeded, as almost 400 different companies were contacted during the project lifetime.

The CPP project has thus undoubtedly succeeded to communicate and disseminate its results. This is essential to the project's goal of bringing about a change of mindset in terms of circular economy thinking related to calls for tenders and public procurement, and acceptance of innovative circular products and services. Although the project is ending, it has produced a range of quality outputs, which are expected to continue to generate interest and present further dissemination opportunities, and it is likely that a follow-up project will be proposed in future, which builds on the successes of Circular PP.
