




Procurement „Catering services for Płavișu gymnasium“

- Płavișu region: 377 km²
- Inhabitants: 5763
- Unemployment: ≈5%
- Budget income 2015: 870 Euro / inhabitant
- Pupils in gymnasium: 419, staff: 67
- Contract: 2018.1.09-2021.31.05

Why?

- Latvian Environmental Investment Fund:
 - Experience pilot circular procurement
- Pļaviņas municipality:
 - Good quality catering for pupils for reasonable price
 - Try out innovative procurement



What we wanted?

Good quality food for reasonable price

Criteria

Economically advantageous selection
Menus correspond to healthy diet



Reduce food and plastic waste


No one way dishes

Organic food

50 % organic mil





How?

- Meetings of procurer and project experts with mayor, school, existing caterer
- Market research
- Experience exchange with neighbouring municipalities
- EU Green procurement guidelines, experience from other schools

What we have achieved?

2 bidders participated

- Contract value: 362 thousands Euro
- Criteria for financial value: price a la carte: 2,69 Euro (nonwinning 1,4 Euro)
- Selection criteria (quality): healthy diet, local food, organic food, school fruit





What we have learned?

- One small line in the tender specification can lead to important changes in the whole organisation
 - Endorcement by leaders
 - Readiness of recipients (Eco-school)
 - Do not judge to quick!
- Market readiness can be higher as thought
- Verification means: know how to measure in advance
- No- breaches of procurement tenders as criterion: only for the same contracting authority
- Importance of monitoring / statistics
