

Balearic economy: specialized on touristic activities






37% of the GVA of the BI corresponds to trade activities, transport and hotel/catering industry

The organic fraction treated was only 3 % of the waste generated

20 % selective collection (2019)

Good practices: Sant Llorenç (Mallorca). 8.328 inhabitants and 20.000 hotel beds

2009. It started the door to door collection with weighing large generators like hotels.

From 9.000 t (2008) to 6.500 t (2014) of waste generation



WASTE MANAGEMENT DRAFT BILL

Measures applicable from 2021 onwards to achieve the objectives

 Payment per generation (PxG): rates depending on the type and quantity generated; bonus of good practices and for reasons of social urgency





 Compulsory selective collection of organic matter (47% by weight of the rest fraction), textiles and also vegetable oil







- Tax for the treatment of waste in landfill and incinerator
- Deposit system for bottles

WASTE MANAGEMENT DRAFT BILL

As of 2021: certain single-use plastic products can not be sold, distributed or used.

 Light and very light bags; rings for cans and bottles of beverages; glasses, plates, cutlery and trays...



Others

 Products containing microplastics or nanoplastics; lighters, razors, cartridges and not reusable toners of printer and photocopier...



• Recyclable or compostable coffee capsules





CIRCULAR ECONOMY ACTIONS

- Support for the process of computerization of green points and payment by waste generation
- ❖ Sustainable tourism tax (ITS) 2016-2019
 - Information and surveillance campaign in spaces of environmental relevance (840.000€)
 - Land cleaning and maintenance of beaches, coves and other public spaces located within places of environmental relevance, with people at risk of social exclusion (500.000€ + 1.500.000€)

- Boosting the social and circular economy (700.000€ + 1.500.000€)
- Pilot test in Formentera of deposit system for 2 years (500.000€)
