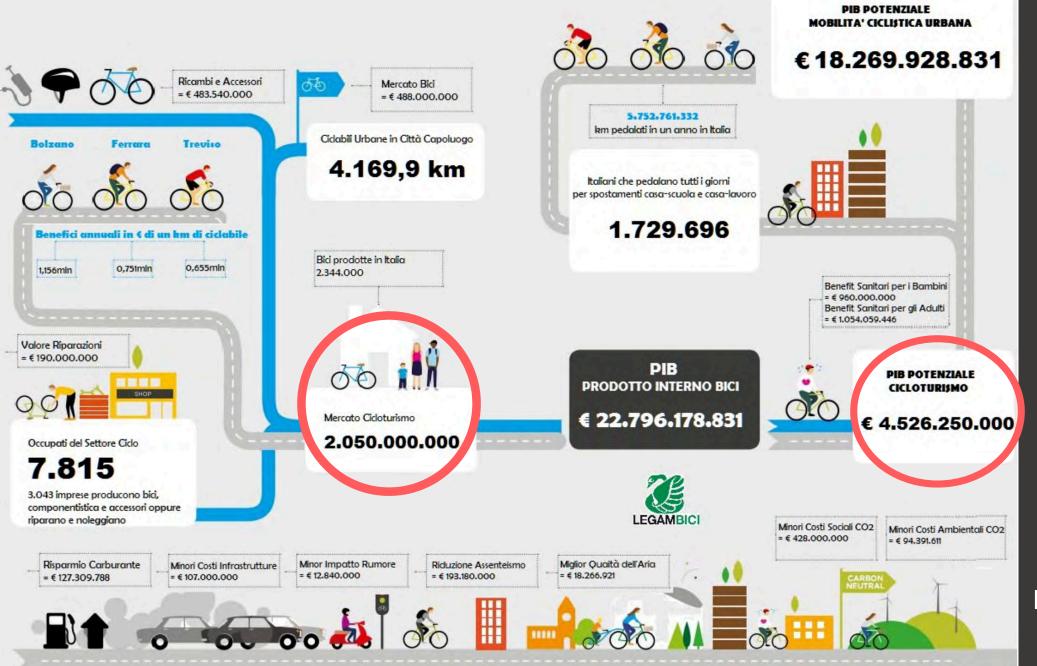

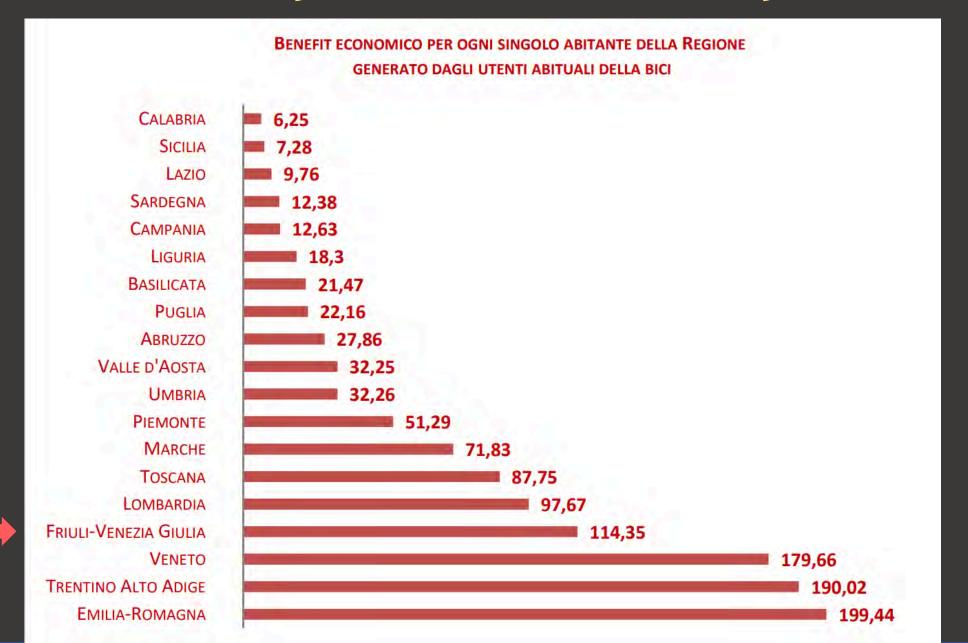

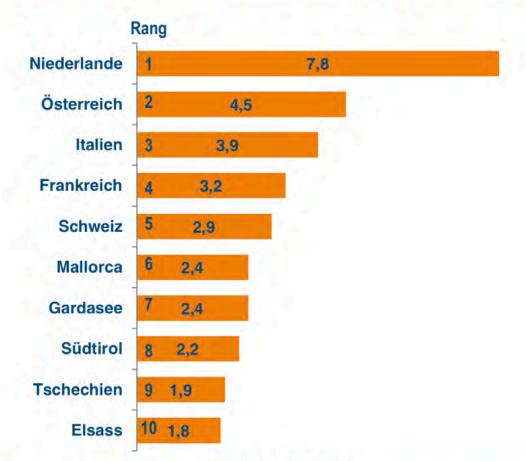

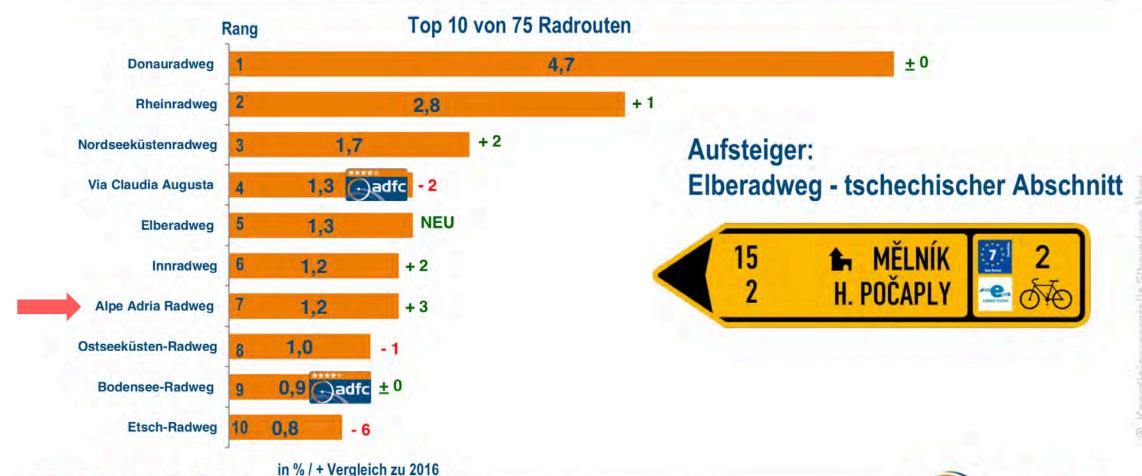

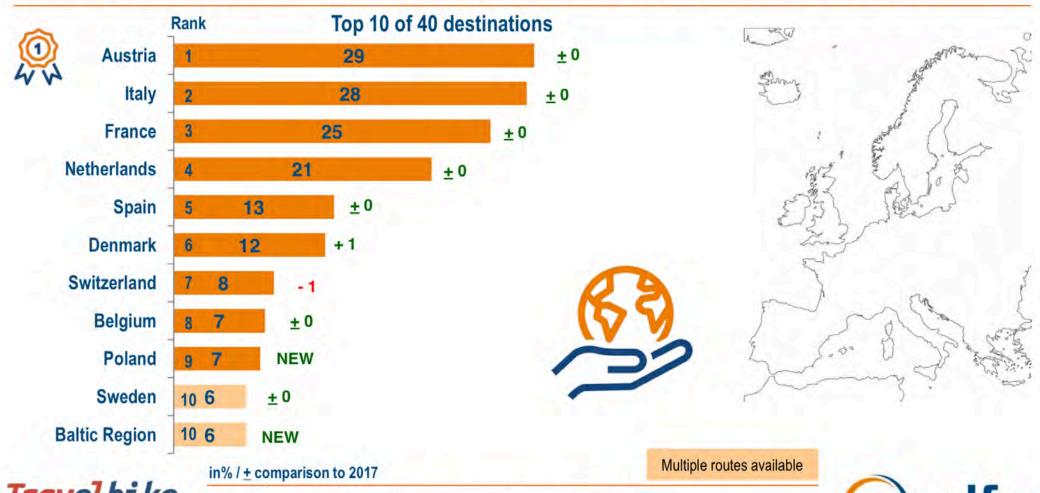








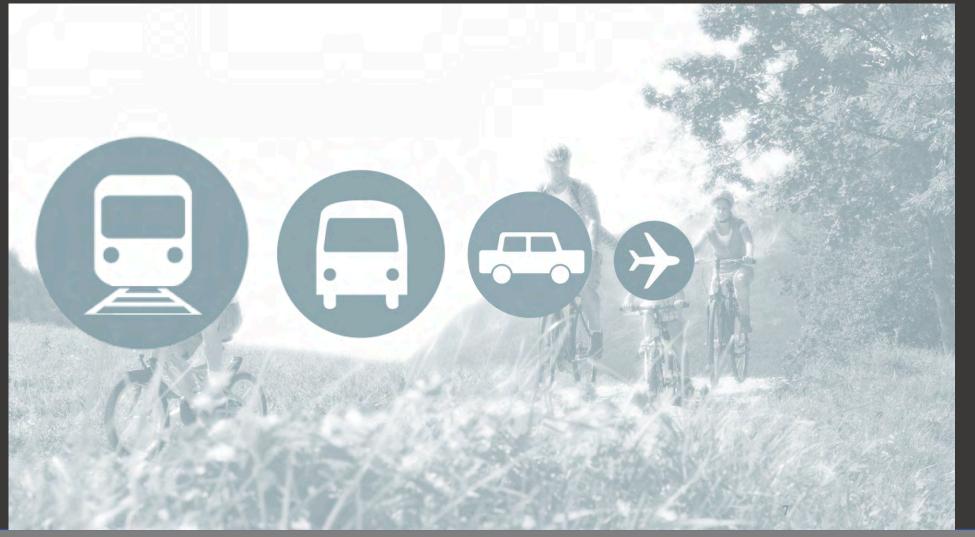
Plan for 2018: travel destinations abroad

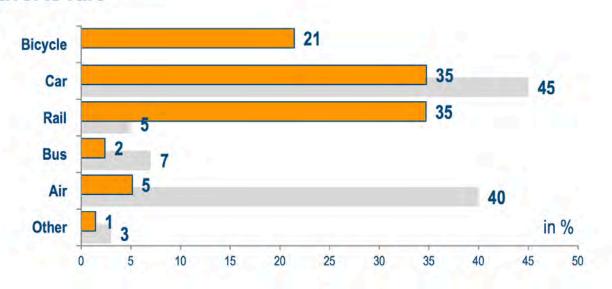

Comparative data: 2016 FUR Travel Analysis, "Other" = bicycle

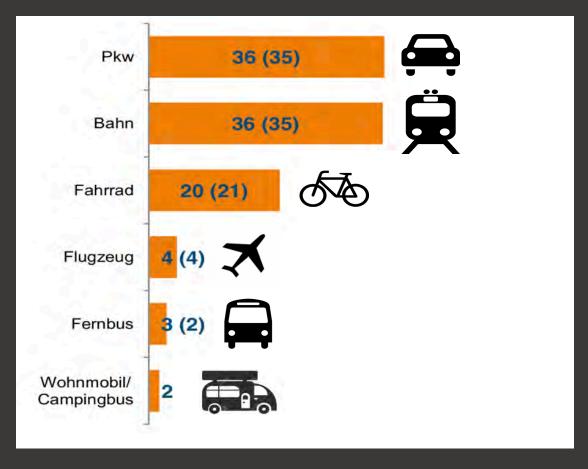

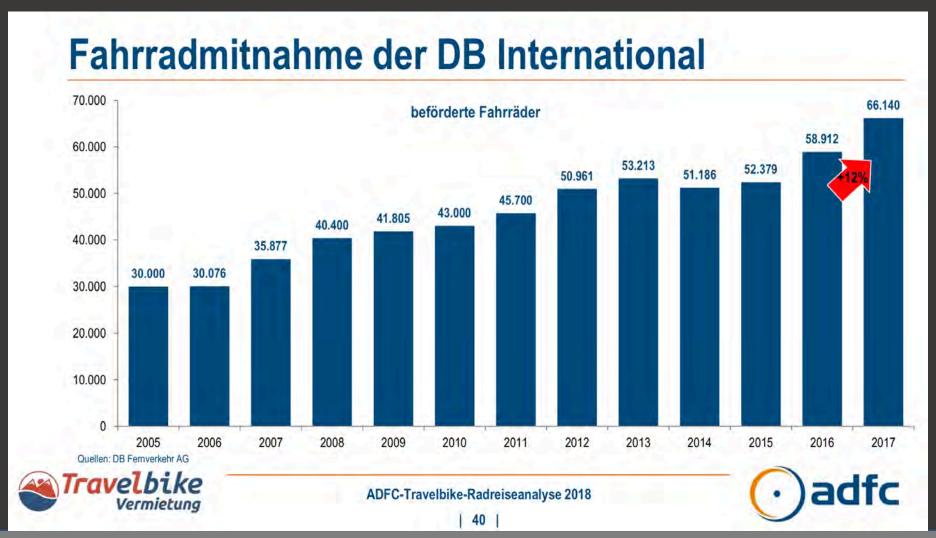
