1 General goal of the event

envirobatBDM organised the CESBA MED Seminar and the CESBA MED training workshop on the 28th March 2019 in Marseille.

Participants were invited to a set of 14 buildings projects presentation, for which the design, work and operation have been improved thanks to assessment approaches. Transdisciplinary teams presented their projects and discussed related issues and feedbacks with a per panel and the audience in a transparent and open dialogue to share one common good : knowledge.

Two CESBA MED partners actually presented their own pilot project. And for the first time the passport produced in CESBA MED was released on another project than the pilot.

To introduce the day, the global project framework was presented including a presentation of the Interreg Med program, of the CESBA MED project as well of participatory approaches as set up in PACA region.

The event took place in EMD premises, a management school, located in the centre. To maximise the understanding and potential exchanges, a dedicated service of simultaneous translation was provided.

2 Goal of the event for participating organisation

Participating organisations benefit of the CESBA MED regional event in different ways. For organisations that presented a project it was a very good opportunity for showcasing their work and skills as well as to network with potential partners or customers.

Such an event is also a great opportunity for stakeholders to discover numerous projects in only one day and one place. Because each project is presented by the teams that eventually set up and implemented the project, they benefit from great feedback. They can identify partners, discuss, network.

It was also a great opportunity for some EnvirobatBDM members to discover the association European work and to actually meet the European partners. There was a real work previous to the event to have exchanges between the organiser and the European guests. A convivial diner was organised the day before to formally make the presentation.
