5th CESBA Sprint Workshop in Malta 2018

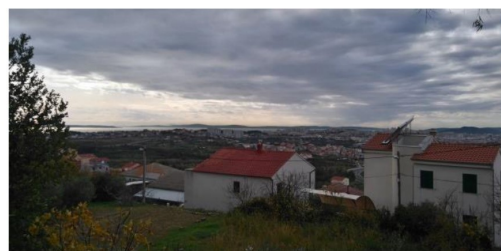

Global level: CESBA MED starts cooperation for its CESBA Neighborhood Award

iiSBE organized a workshop at UN Environment Economy Division in Paris on Jan 17th-18th. Recent initiatives in the assessment of neighborhood performance were presented and ideas on future directions shared. Finally the CESBA Neighborhood Award results will be presented on the global conference of the Sustainable Built Environment (SBE) series of conferences operated by the SBE partnership, a consortium of CIB, iiSBE, UNEP-SBCI, FIDIC and the Global Alliance for Buildings and Construction (Global ABC) in Göteborg 2020. Further collaborations shall emerge

Partner AURA-EE presented the LEVEL(s) initiative during a CESBA Local Committee on Nov 30th. Level(s) is a voluntary reporting framework to improve the sustainability of buildings. Using existing standards, Level(s) provides a common EU approach to the assessment of environmental performance in the built environment.

Territorial level: SN-Tool tested in a neighborhood area



The CESBA MED local committee (CLC) was constituted by Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar in November 2017 in Split and Dalmatia region. The CLC focused CESBA MED indicators on local specific needs. Data from strategic, energy and other development plans of the County and the cities contain most of the data to calculate the indicators. It will be the first time to test the CESBA SN-Tool. The education program for stakeholders is welcomed. The study results for building capacities on sustainable development and management of neighborhoods are crucial.
