CESBA - A movement towards a harmonization of sustainable built environment assessments throughout Europe!



4th CESBA SPRINT WORKSHOP

September 18th - 20th, 2017

Bezau / Vorarlberg / AUSTRIA

90 experts from 13 nations developed joint solutions for the development of the built environment. The 4th CESBA Sprint Workshop was organized by 9 European projects in collaboration with the Vorarlberg Institute of Architecture under patronage of the government of Vorarlberg.

Main organizing project: CESBA Alps.
Contributing projects: CESBA MED, GREENCYCLE, PEACE_Alps, THE4BEES, GRETA, IMEAS, CaSCo, New TREND.

The most important results regarding the project CESBA MED are:

- CESBA supports transnational KPIs, reaching from buildings to neighbourhoods to municipalities and to territories.
- KPIs are suitable to share objectives, to connect local actions to wider goals and programs. KPIs help to visualize the progress and make impact visible. KPIs help learn, compare, monitor and assess progress and exemplify best practices.

- The involvement of users is the base. The drivers for user involvement are awareness raising, services, incentives and legislation.
- The draft version of a generic framework for neighbourhood evaluation is composed by more than 150 assessment criteria organized in different topics. The new LEVELS approach from the European Commission has been integrated.
- Nevertheless there is a need to make the generic framework understandable to all. The assessment shall have a participatory approach with many advantages such as transparency, experience sharing, contextualization and involvement of stakeholders.
- The draft version of the CESBA Sustainable Neighbourhood Award 2019 has been evaluated. As a next step the partnership for the award shall be enlarged.
