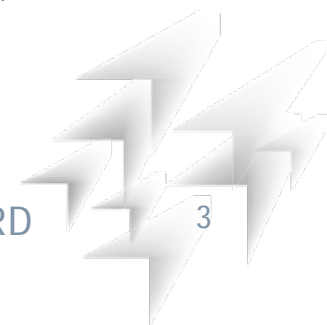

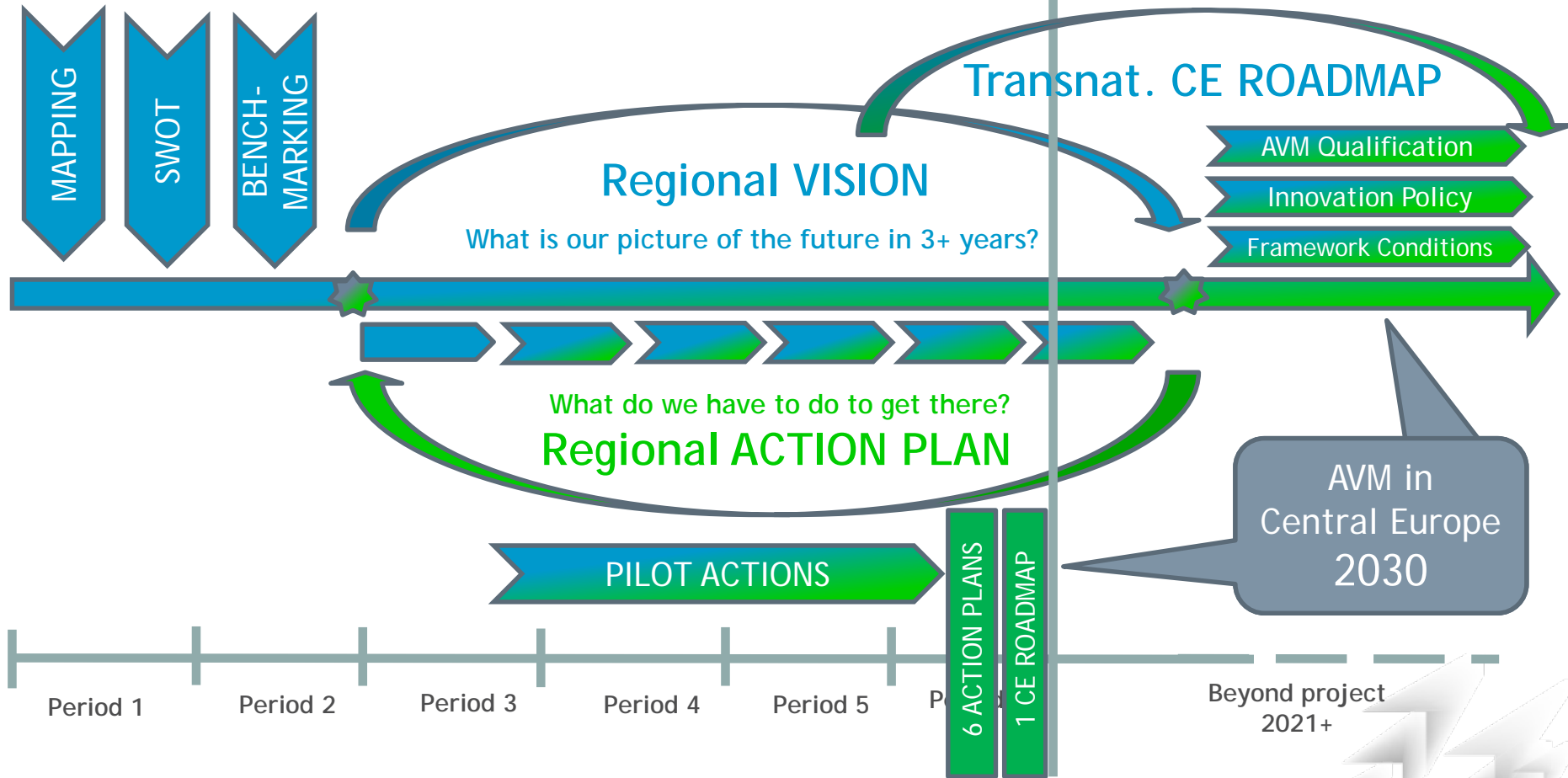
D.T1.2.3 - Regional Action Plans for each partner region

- Serves as input for transnat. CE strategy Roadmap (D.T1.4.2)



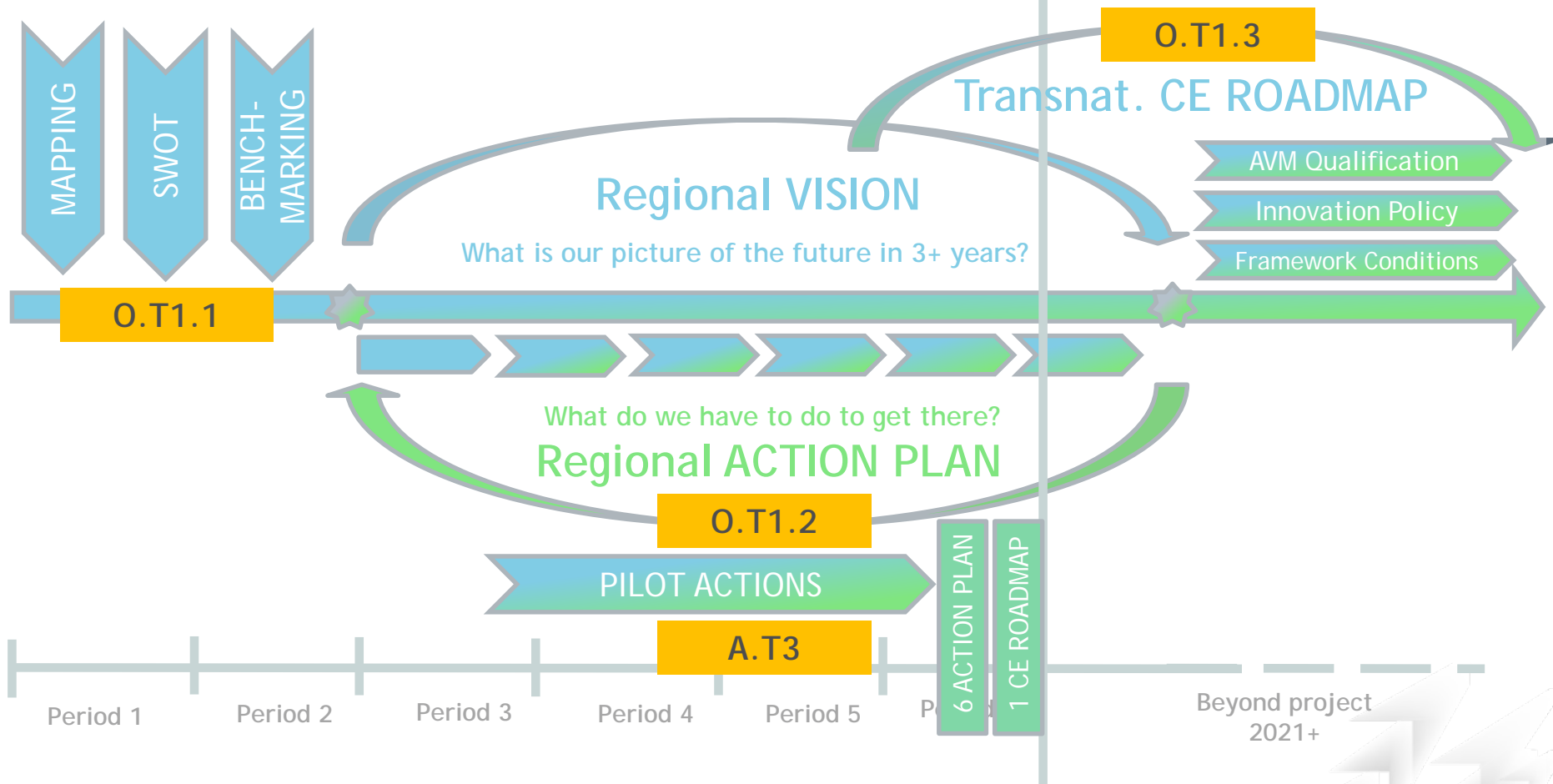

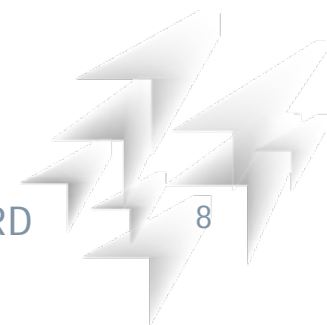
D.T1.2.3 - Status of Draft Action Plans received from PPs

- In some RAPs description of Actions should be more future-oriented



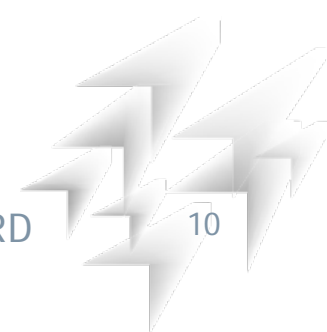
