Cooperation is funded in 107 cross-border, transnational and interregional programmes




Focus on results



Where do we stand? 85 transnational projects, worth 160m EUR ERDF, are implementing smart solutions facing challenges shared across central European regions in the fields of:





- > Continuation of the successful cooperation on culture heritage
- Goal: To improve capacities for the sustainable use of cultural heritage and resources (SO 3.2)
- After two calls:


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- 16 culture projects approved
 - 29,2 million EUR ERDF allocated
 - 174 partners cooperating

Thematic clustering of approved projects (16 projects) - after two calls





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Third call for proposals closes on 25 January 2018



- 60 million EUR ERDF ~ 20 million EUR ERDF on natural and cultural resources
- Thematic focus on cultural and creative industries in SO 3.2
