As the focus of environmental and sustainability awareness campaigns is usually around children from 7 to 99 years old, one school decided to push its limitations and boldly go where no one had</p>

	<p>gone before.</p> <p>In effect, one of the candidates for the TEESCHOOLS Academy was the HappiNest Pre-school, that happily mixes approaches of fun learning and just plain cocooning for kids ranging from 2 and a half to 5 years old.</p> <p>It was in this setting that our team presented the first steps towards sustainability to 7 children of the HappiNest school. Using a game that introduced energy as a concept and a means to make things work (cars, planes, wind mill, lights...), the little ones were invited to find which energy suited which usage and were later made aware of what energy polluted the most and which ones were renewable.</p> <p>The context of this school that encourages local and seasonal resources made it easy to connect the different themes and gives hope that total sustainability is possible and it is through these initiatives that it will be achievable.</p> <p>Thank you HappiNest for your warm welcome and congratulations for entering our contest!"</p>
