

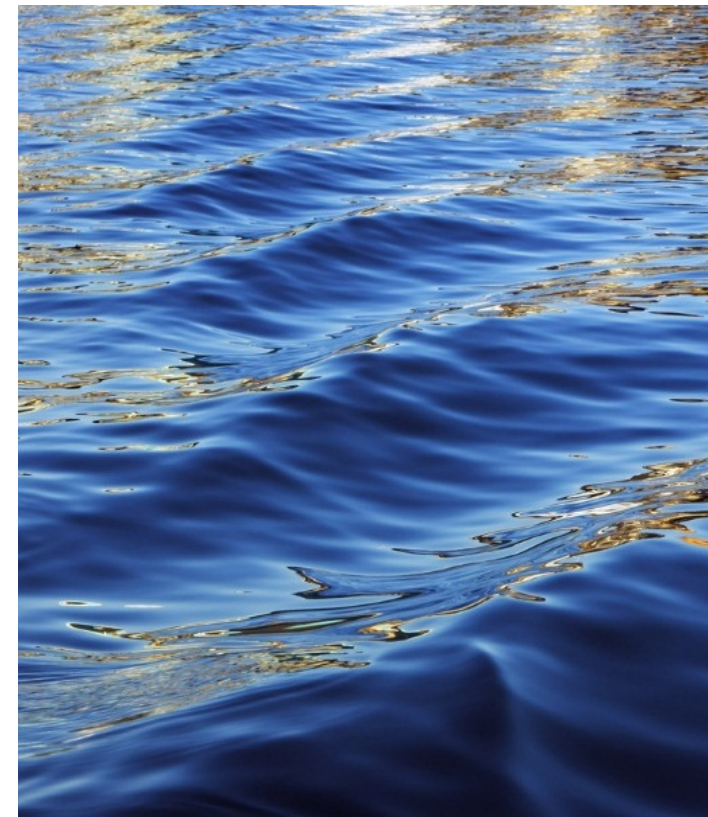

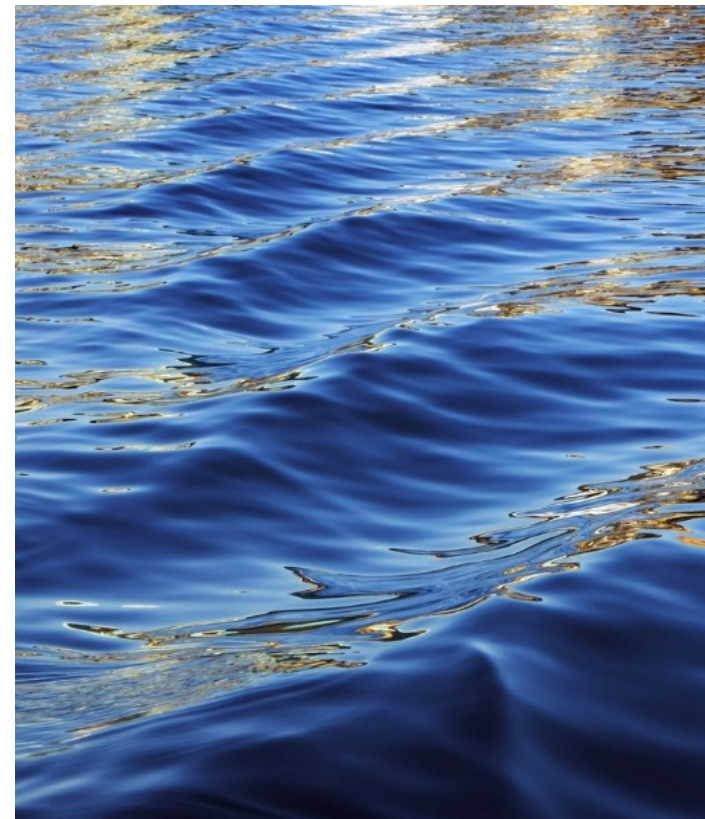

Green Fund scope is to:

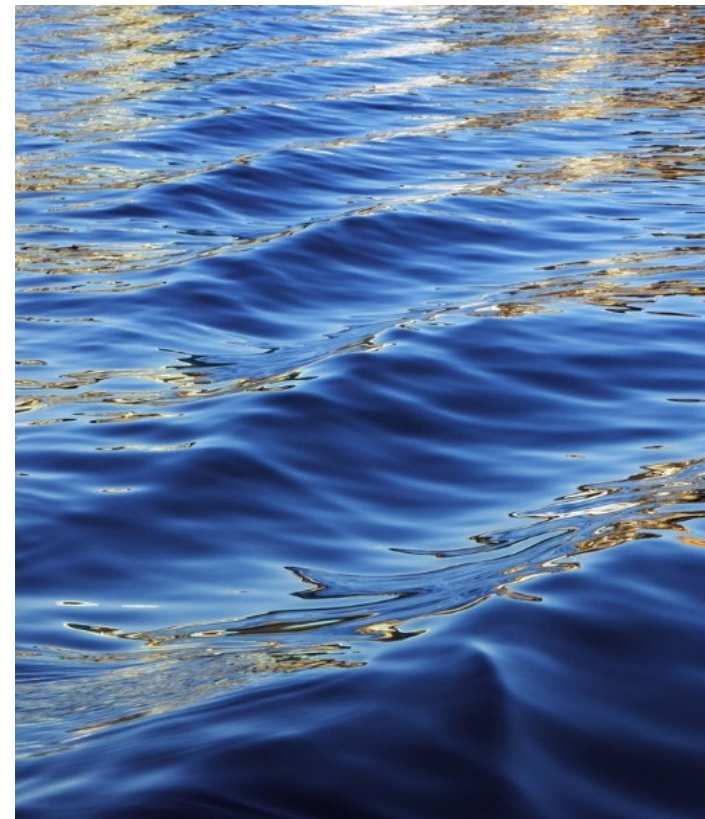
- ✓ enhance development through environmental protection,

- GF Resources: M.D. 4503/2012



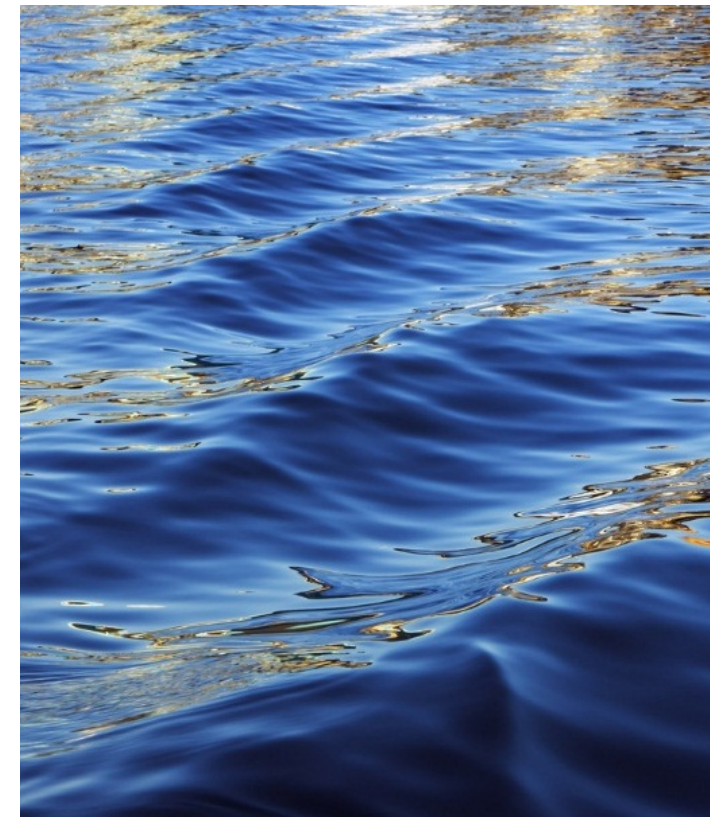
