

### 2.4.3 Participation to external event – “Energy efficiency through implementation of EU projects”

Organized by EIHP (Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar) and the Croatian Chamber of Commerce – the County Chamber of Split, on April 19, 2019, an external workshop “Energy efficiency through implementation of EU projects” was held in the conference hall of the County Chamber of Split.

The workshop has laid the foundations for cooperation and finding synergy with projects that are being carried out by City of Split:

TEESCHOOLS (Interreg Mediteran) and FEEDSCHOOLS (Interreg Central Europe), whose aim to provide new technical solutions for the transfer of energy efficiency in selected elementary schools in the Split area, which will assist local authorities in proven activities that will help with implementation of nearly zero energy building standard (NZEB) in selected schools. The innovative approach consists of the development of transnational and holistic support tools and web-based databases of the best innovative practices for the NZEB's renewal for the Mediterranean and Central European schools.

Ivan Bačan (EIHP) referred to sustainability indicators for urban areas developed under the CESBA MED project from the Interreg Mediteran program. The project developed a methodology for transnational comparison of buildings and / or urban environments and successfully motivated JLS beneficiaries for sustainable planning in urban environments.

Leila Luttenberger (EIHP) presented new projects: “RESPONSE” from the Interreg Italia-Croatia program on mitigation and adaptation to climate changes, and the “PROSPECT2030” project from the Interreg Central Europe Program, which will provide regional self-governments guidance to achieve low carbon emissions by 2030 with special reference to the exploitation of renewable energy sources.
