

ENEA at “Energy efficiency 2.0” in Treviso, Italy

The LP of FEEDSCHOOLS project, ENEA, has been invited to the national event organised by the Province of Treviso on February 7th, 2018 “Energy Efficiency 2.0”. The event was focused on energy efficiency, measures, best practices and carbon footprint of public buildings organized in the framework of two ongoing projects coordinated by the Province of Treviso: the Interreg MED Programme EduFootprint project and the Central Europe Together - TOwards a Goal of Efficiency THrough Energy Reduction project.

A morning session focused on the presentation of the main topics linked to energy efficiency have been organized, including the presentation of Maria-Anna Segreto from ENEA focused on the application of the nZEB Directive. Besides, ENEA has presented the FEEDSCHOOL and TEESCHOOL projects main objectives and the achieved results during a round table focused on the sharing of similar experiences from Interreg projects, funded by Central Europe and MED Programme.

The event represented a strategic opportunity for a fruitful exchange of experiences among subjects that for various purposes, such as research, didactic, professional, entrepreneurial, are reflecting on the topics related to behavioral change and its impact to accelerate time or reduce costs of energy efficiency in the various uses of energy - with a specific reference to lighting and heating of public buildings.
