

TRAINING ACTIONS EARTH SENSE PROJECT | COPPER COAST UGG

Last June the Atlantic-geoparks project partners where gathered on the Crozon Peninsula, located in the territory of the Armorik Nature Park, one of the two aspiring Geoparks that composes the partnership. This was an important opportunity for each partner share their experience and show different systems of managing a Geopark, identifying best practices and exchanging know-how, therefore supporting Armorik Geopark candidacy.

Currently, there is no Geopark recognized by UNESCO on the French Atlantic coast, so the Armorik Aspiring Geopark, with the support of the project partners will keep working to obtain this distinction and become the first UNESCO Global Geopark on the French Atlantic coast.


